


Letters learned in the first series:


Letters to be learned in this series:

This is the letter "h." The letter "h" sounds like the wind — "hhhh." That's what the letter "h" says, like in hand, heart, house and hen.




The letter "h" looks like the letter "n," except that the letter "h" has a stick.

Let's see who can make the "hhhhh" sound the longest!


Let's use our hands to make the letters "h" and "n":

ham him




One day, a hamster comes to visit SID and SIS.


"Hello," says the hamster.

ham the hamster."




sid suddenly feels very,

his little hands.




Sid opens a cupboard and takes out some bread.


Then Sid opens the fridge.

"Mustard or mayonnaise?"




ham is happy about mayonnaise, but not mustard. "Just mayo," says ham.

On the bread.




"Ewww!" says ham.

mustard On the bread.




"Pickles?" asks **SIC**.

putting three big pickles


On the bread.

On my sandwich!"




"Pickles are the best," says

sandwich.




sid holds up the

sandwich."




But instead of getting

bite of the sandwich.




"Oh, my!" says ham,

cook in the world."




Sid forgets that he is

I am. Please continue..."




ham is happy to

continue. "This is the best,"


says ham. "I can't
