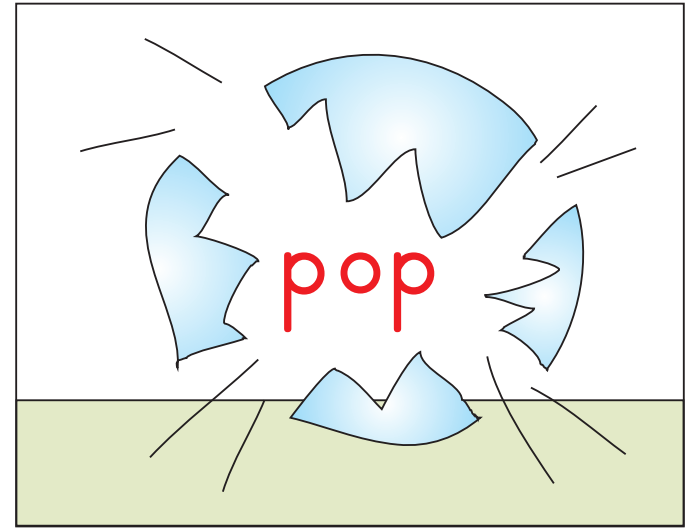
bag



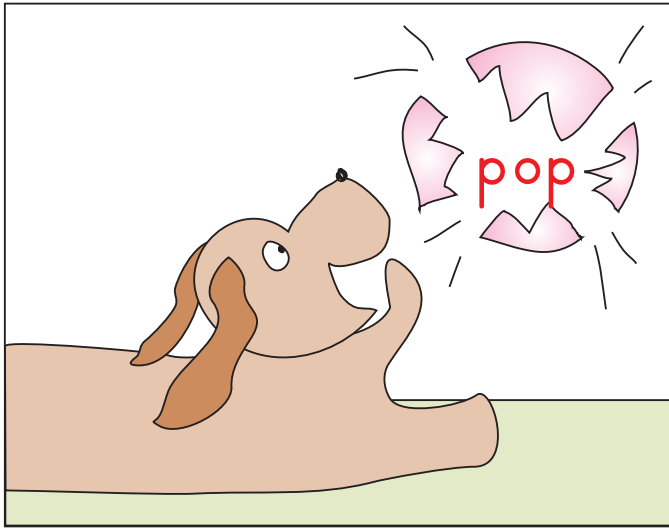
One day, **big pig** brings a **bag** of balloons to the **dog** park.



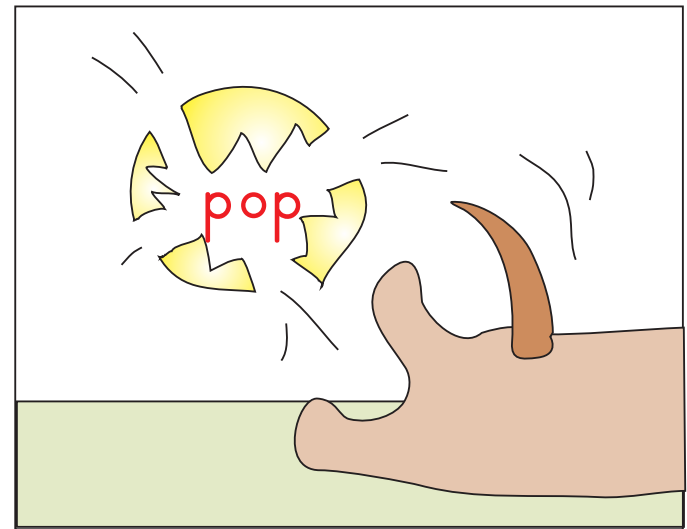
"Watch this," says **big**

blows up a balloon.



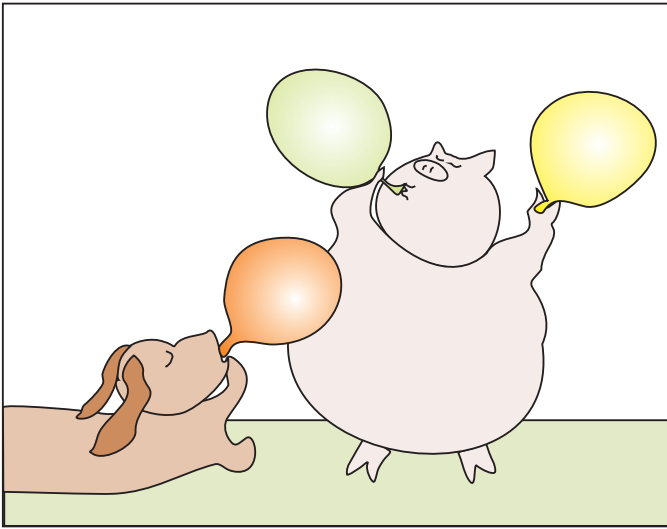
Then he sticks it with

**bob** wags his tail.



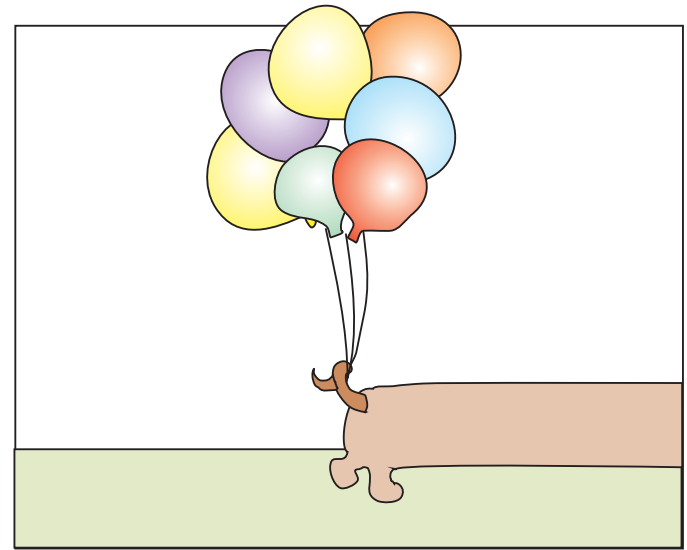
"My turn!" says **dod**.

it with a pin. **pop**!



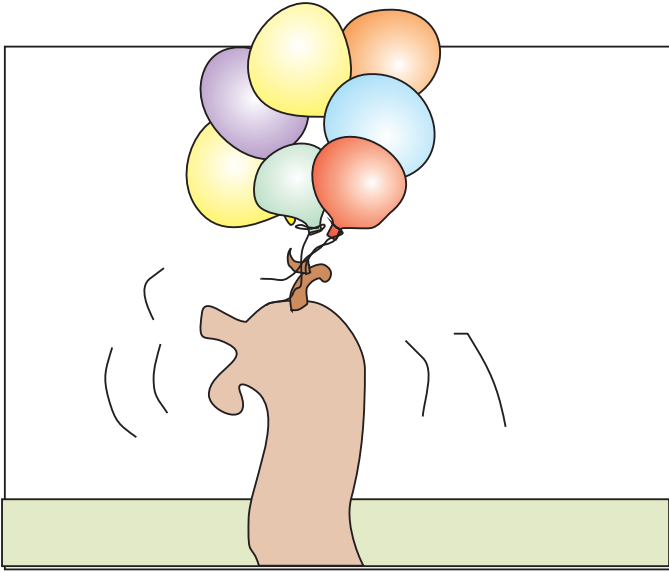
**bob** has no mouth,

his tail. **pop**!



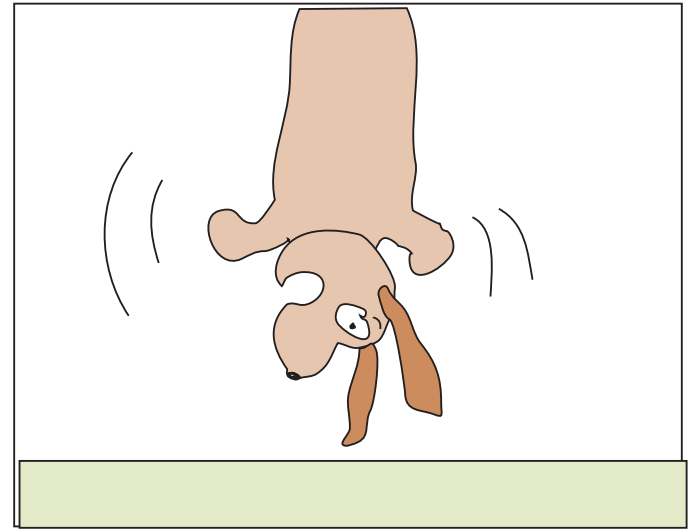
“Let’s **pop** lots of balloons,” says **dod**.  
So **dod** and **big pig** blow up lots of balloons.



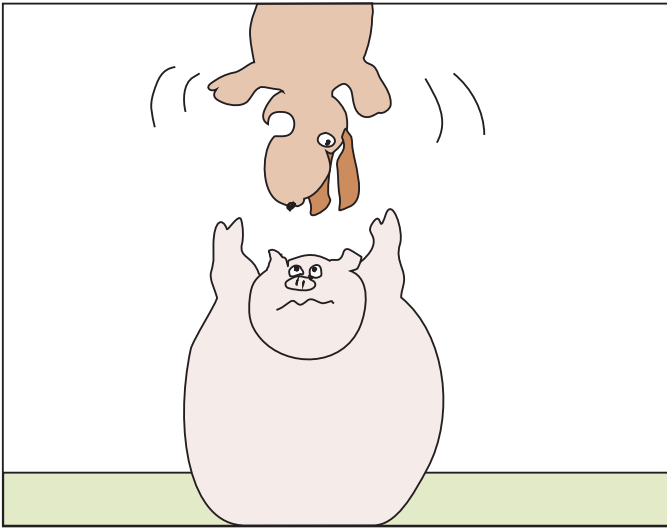
**bob** holds the balloons with his tail.

goes up, up and up.

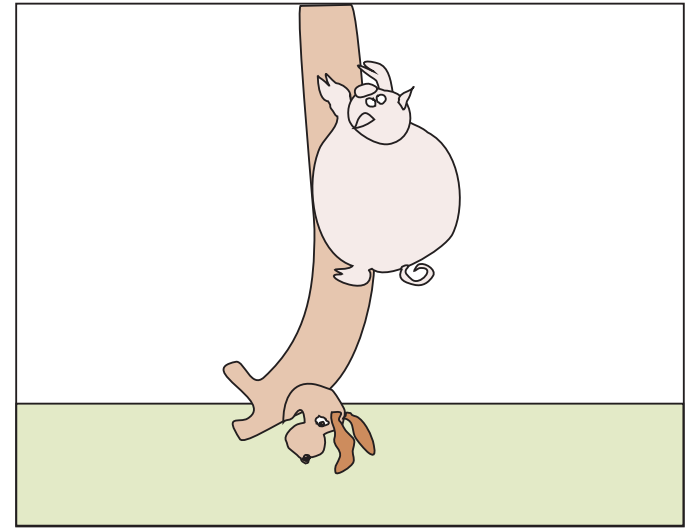


And because **dod**

and up.



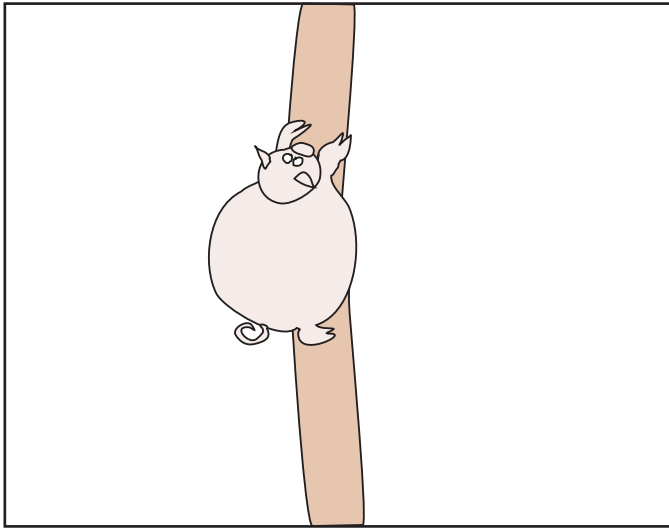
“Quick!” says **dod**

balloons!”

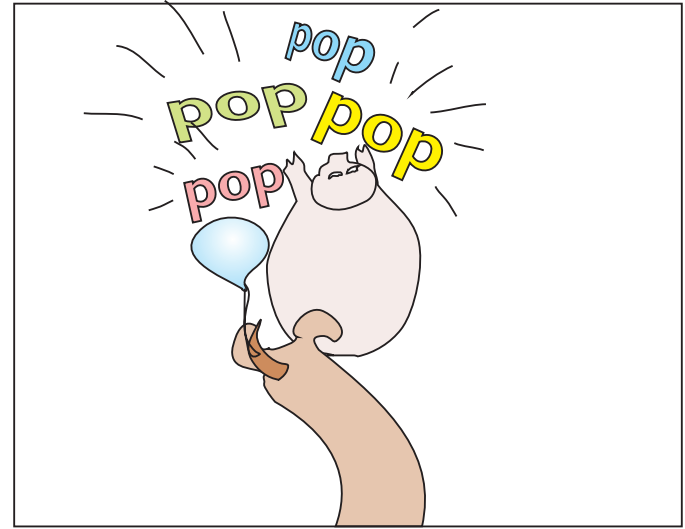


“Don’t worry!” says

**pop** the balloons.”

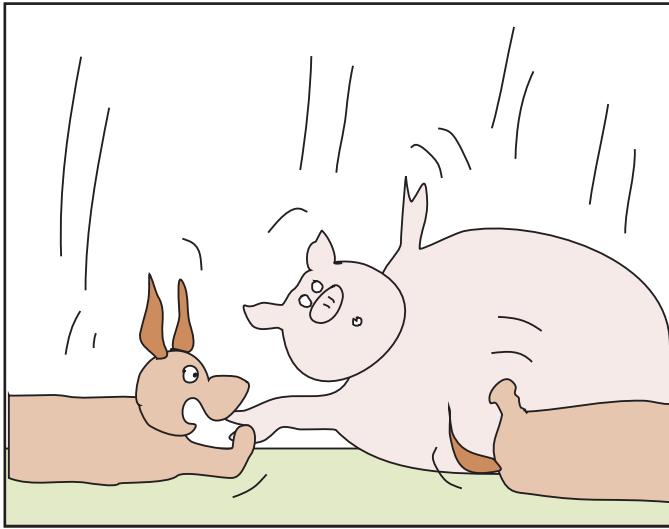


Because **dod** is such

the balloons.

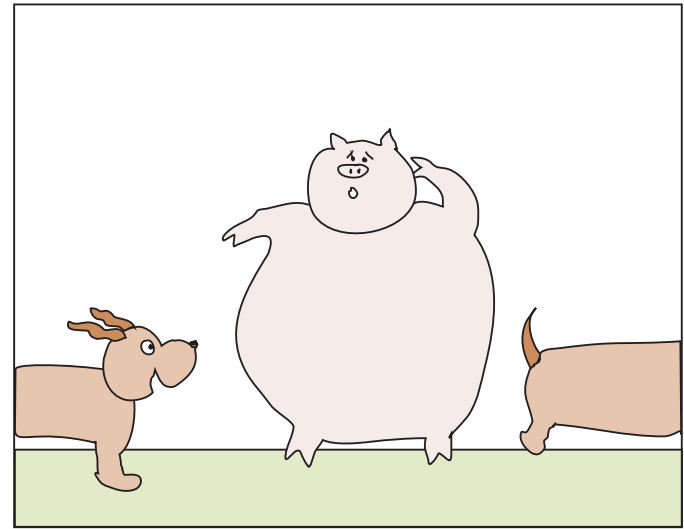


**pop**... **pop**...

**pop**...

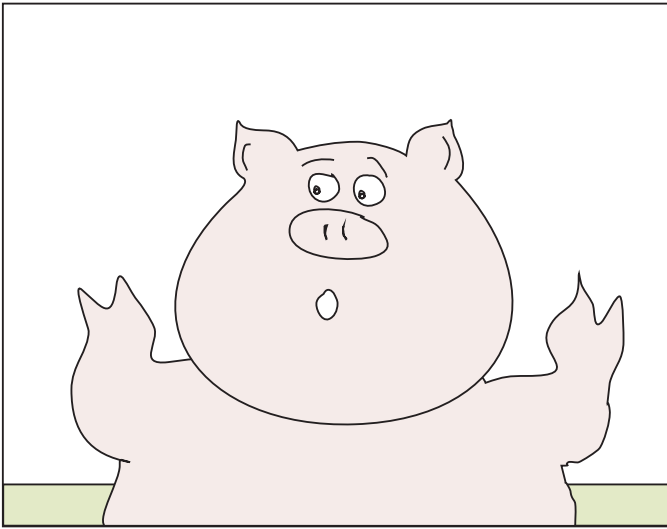




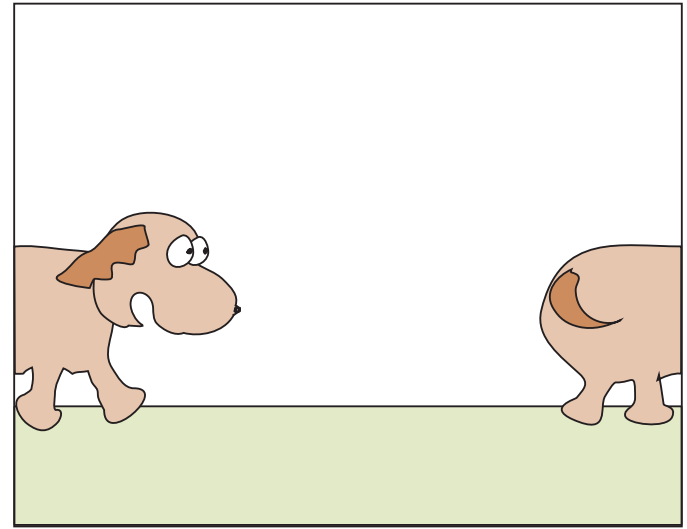
They all fall down to the

and **bob** are saved!



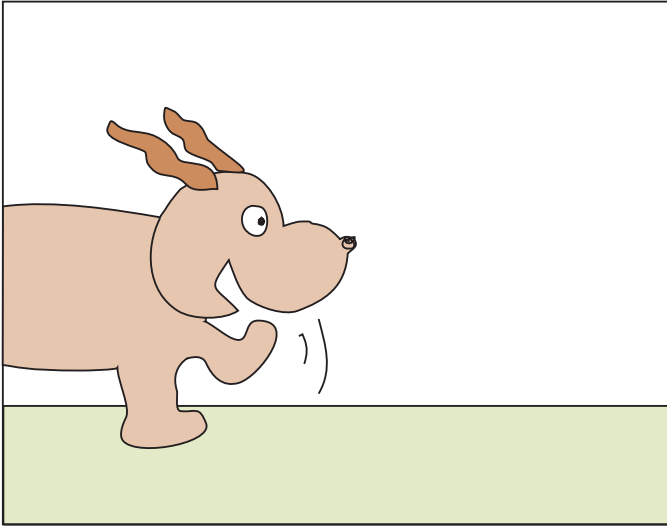
**big pig** looks at

of the same **dog**?”

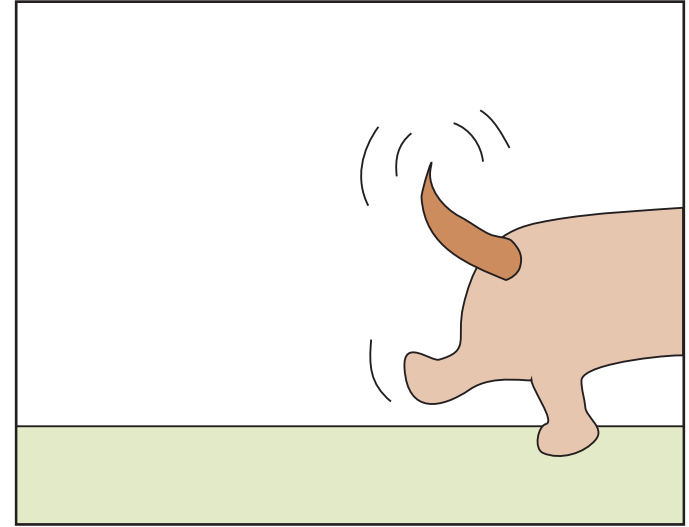


**dod** looks at **bob** ,
