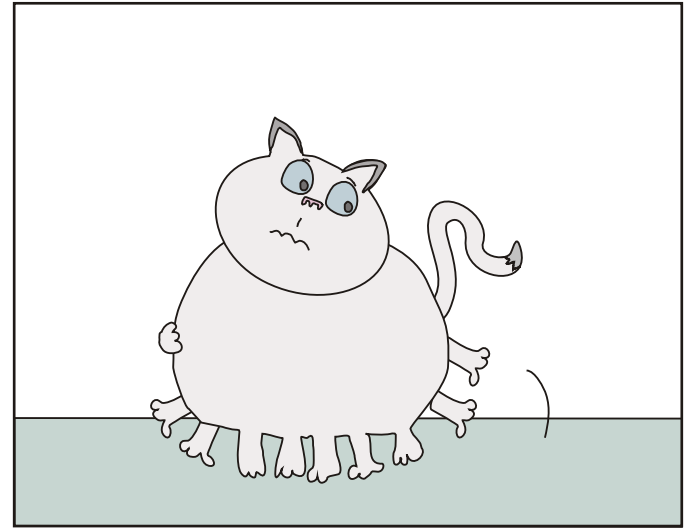
One morning, **tom**

walk.



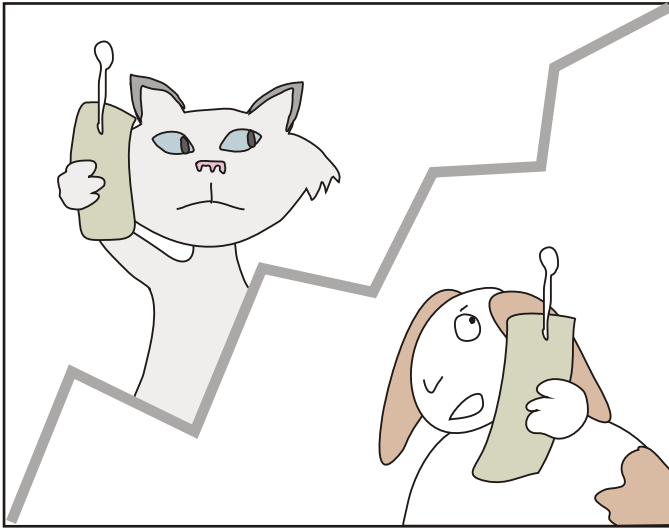
"Help!" says **tom**.

his two tiny teeth.



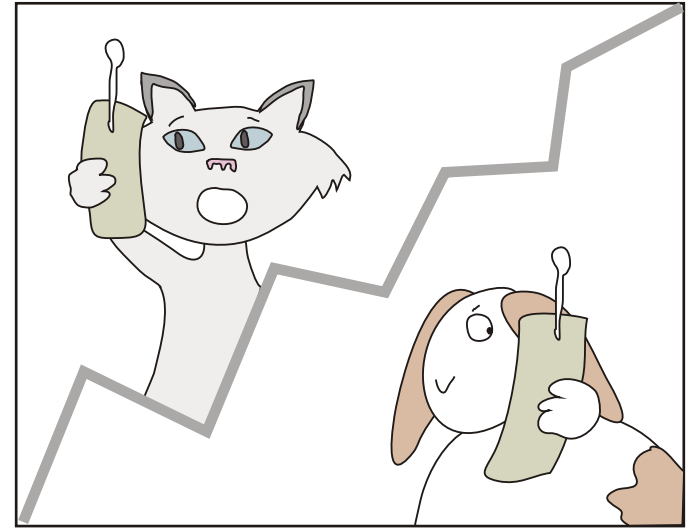
“This **leg**,” says **tom**.

"Hello?" says the rabbit.



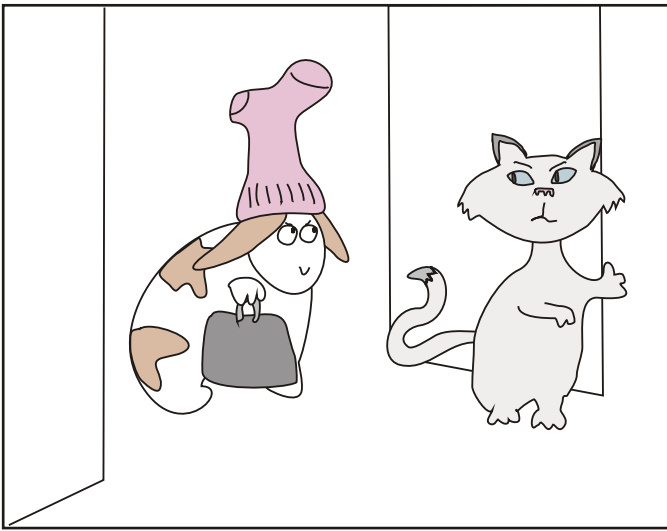
"Help! We need a doctor.

his leg."

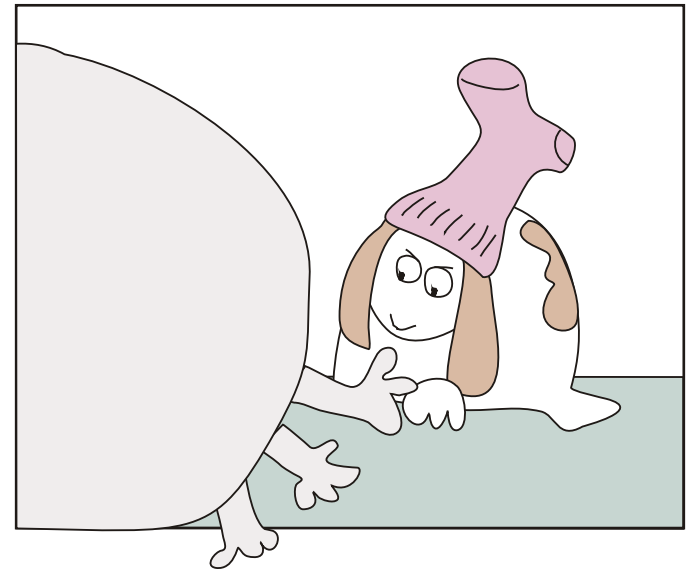
"I will be right there,"

says the rabbit.

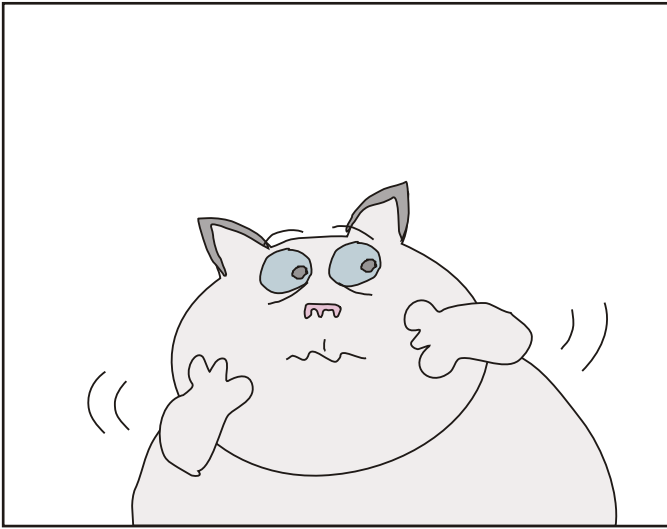


The rabbit puts a sock

on the door.

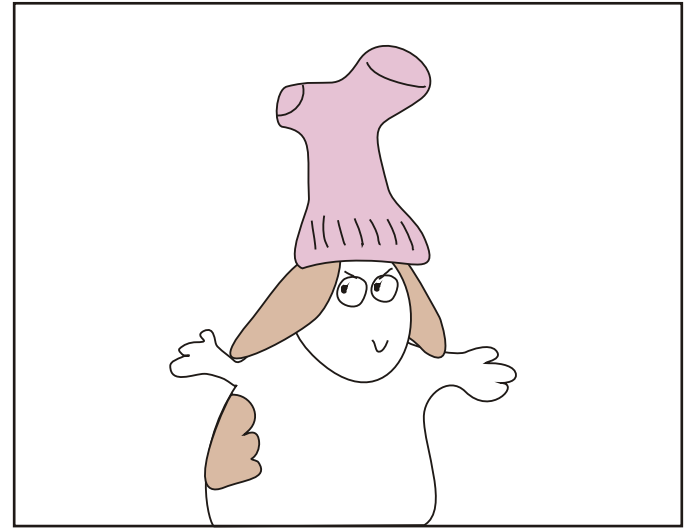
"My brother's **leg** is
over there," says **tim**.



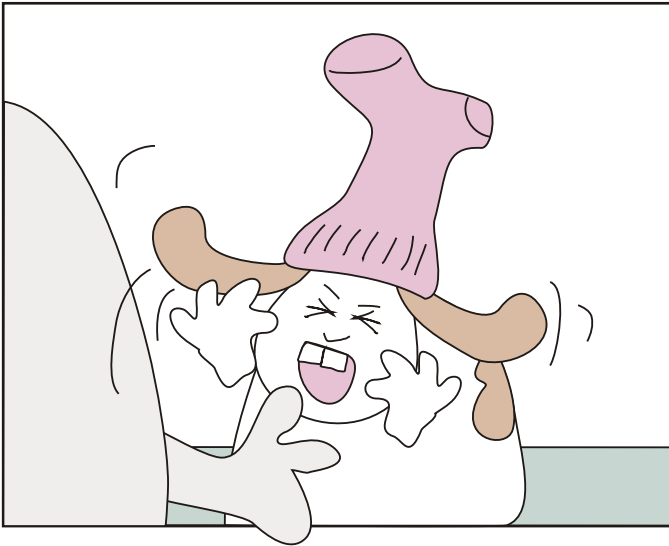
"This is very **bad**," says

have to **cut it** off."



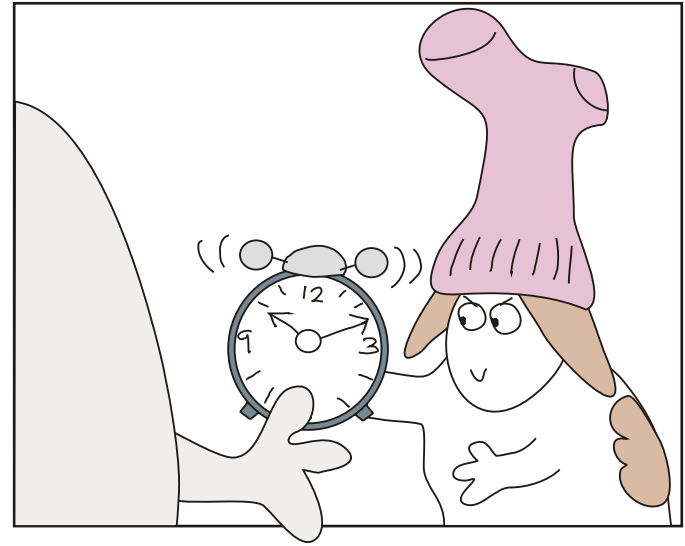
“cut off my leg?”

sleeping!”



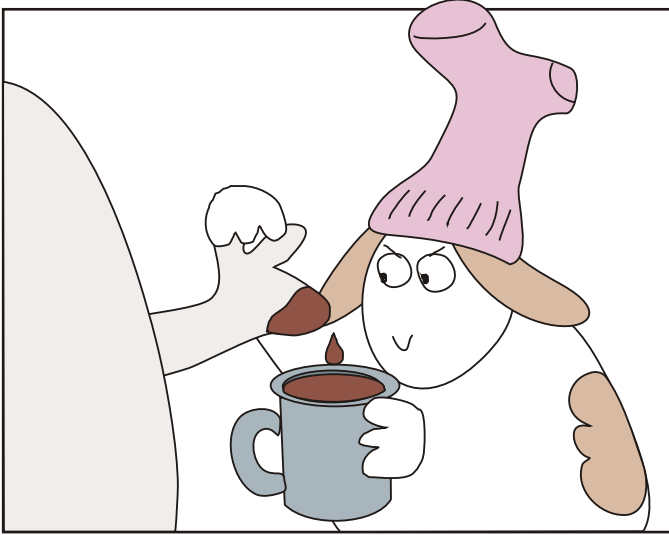
“I do not think so,”

your leg.”



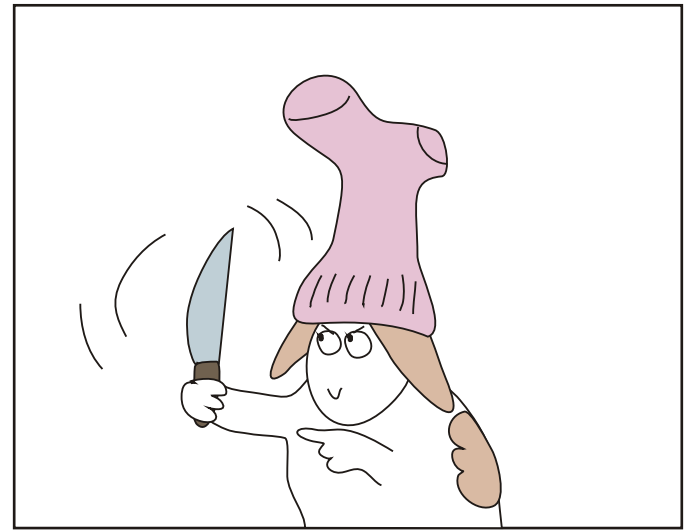
“Wake **up**!” shouts the

not wake **up**.



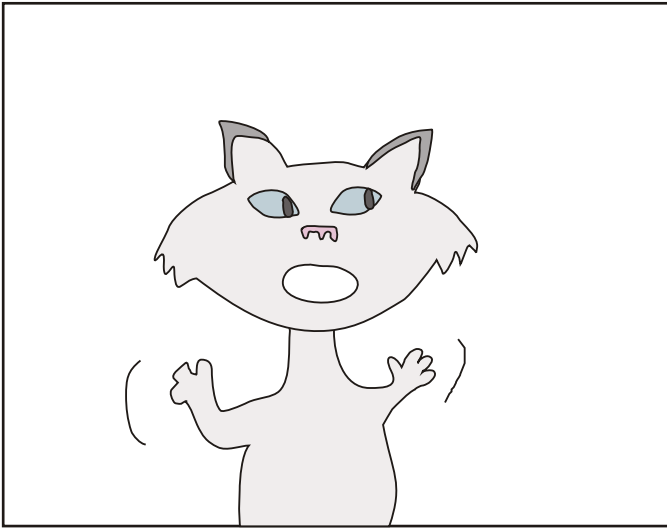
The rabbit rings **an**

wake **up**.



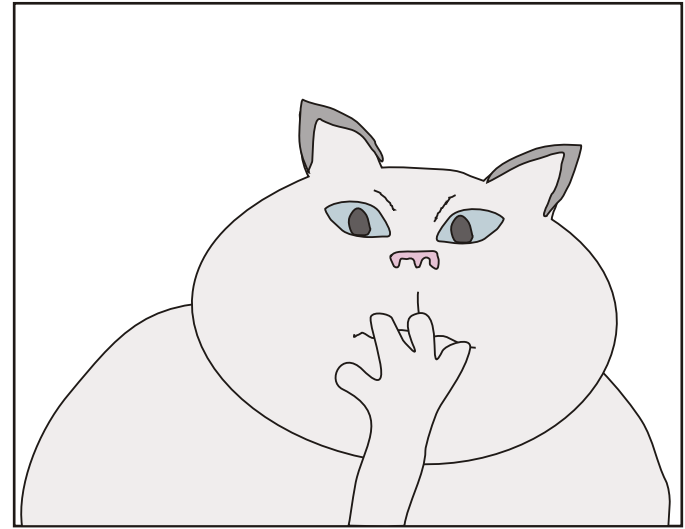
The rabbit dips the **leg**

does **not** wake **up**.



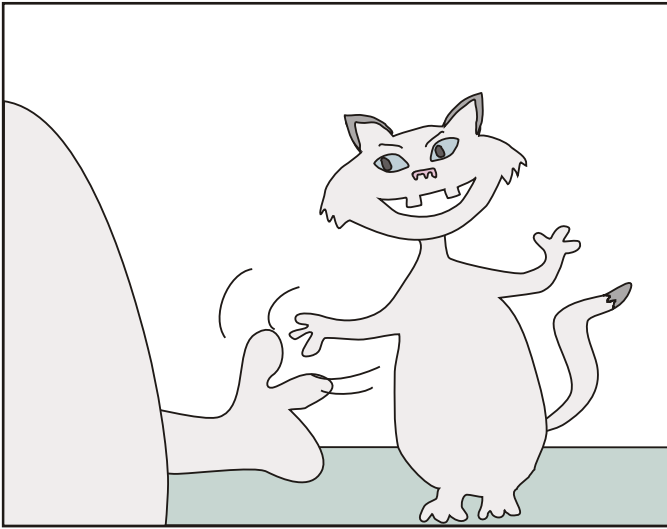
The rabbit shakes his head.

that would wake **it** up.”

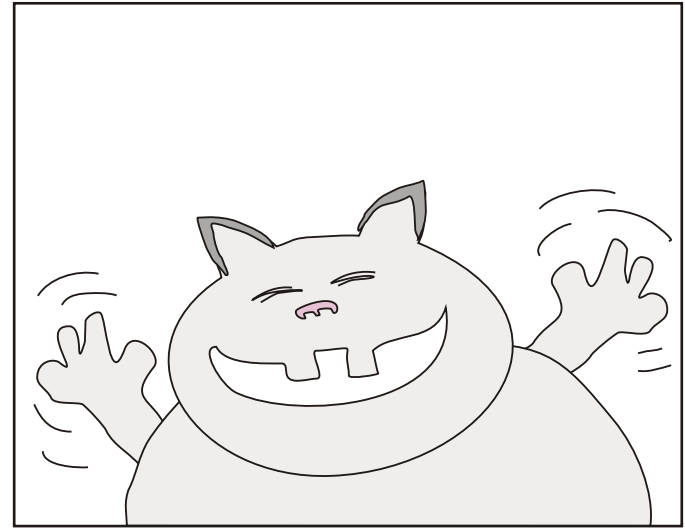


“I do **not** like pickles,”
says **tom**.



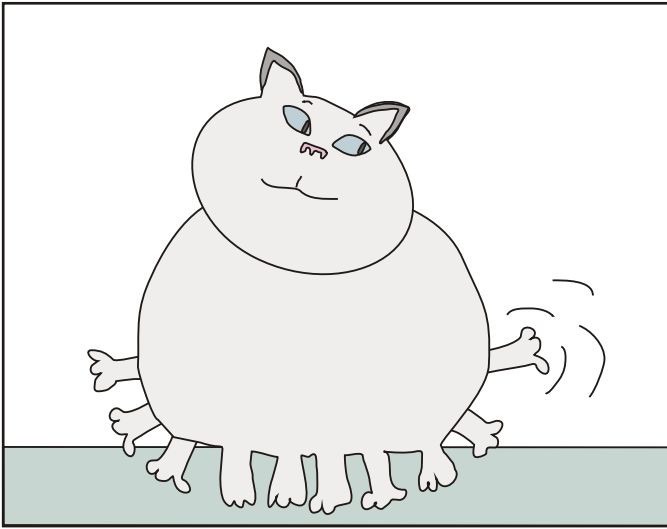
"I said TICKLE, **not**

"Like this!"

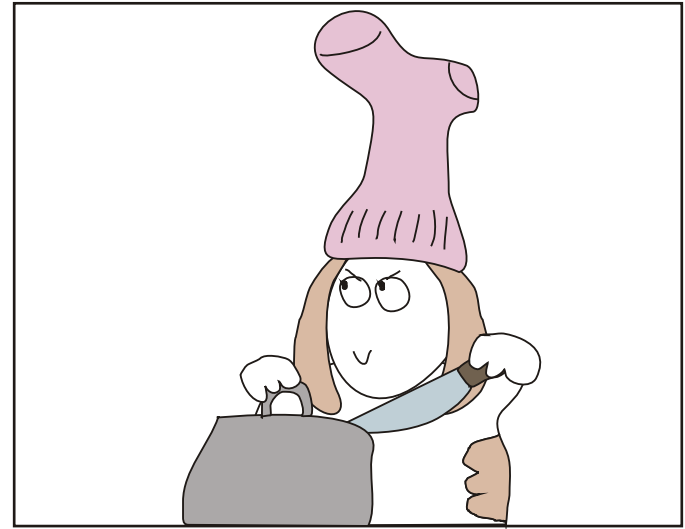


"Oh, ha, ha," says **tom**.

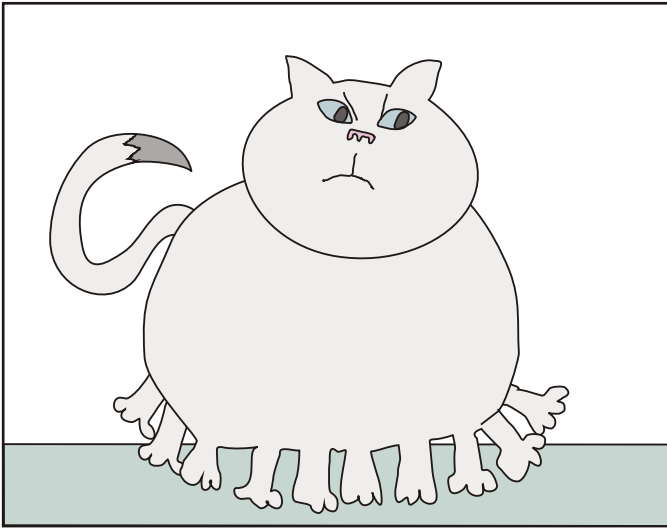
"Stop! Stop!"

leg!" says **tom**.

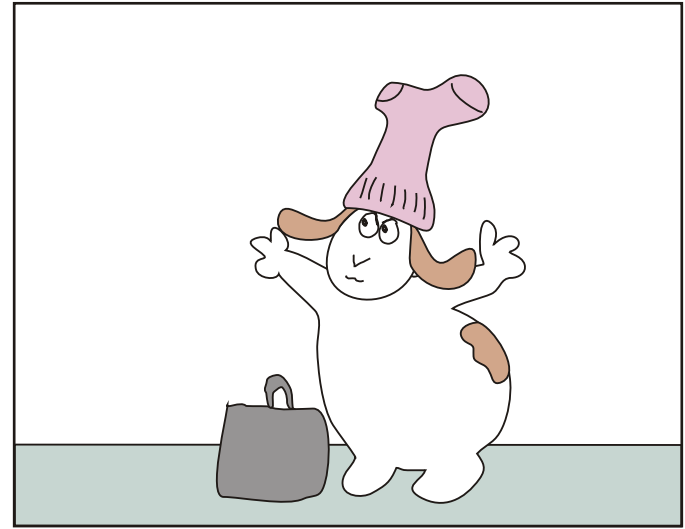


"What **did** I tell you?"
