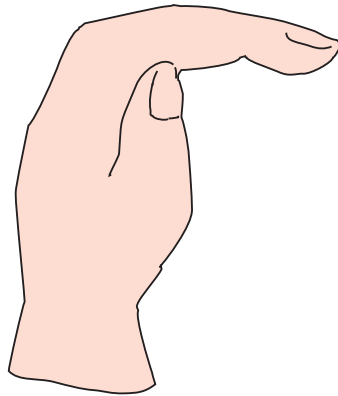
This is the letter "r." The letter "r" says "-rrr-" like in rain, rabbit, ring, rocket and rhinoceros.



The letter "r" looks a lot like the letter "f," except that it is shorter and doesn't have a stick across the middle.



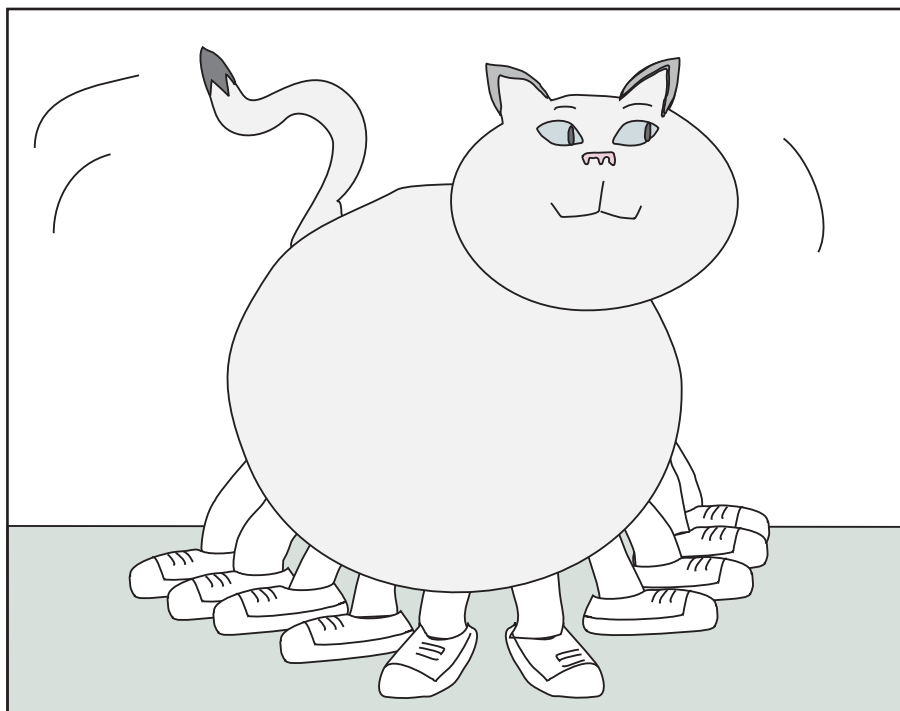
We can make the letter "r" with one hand.



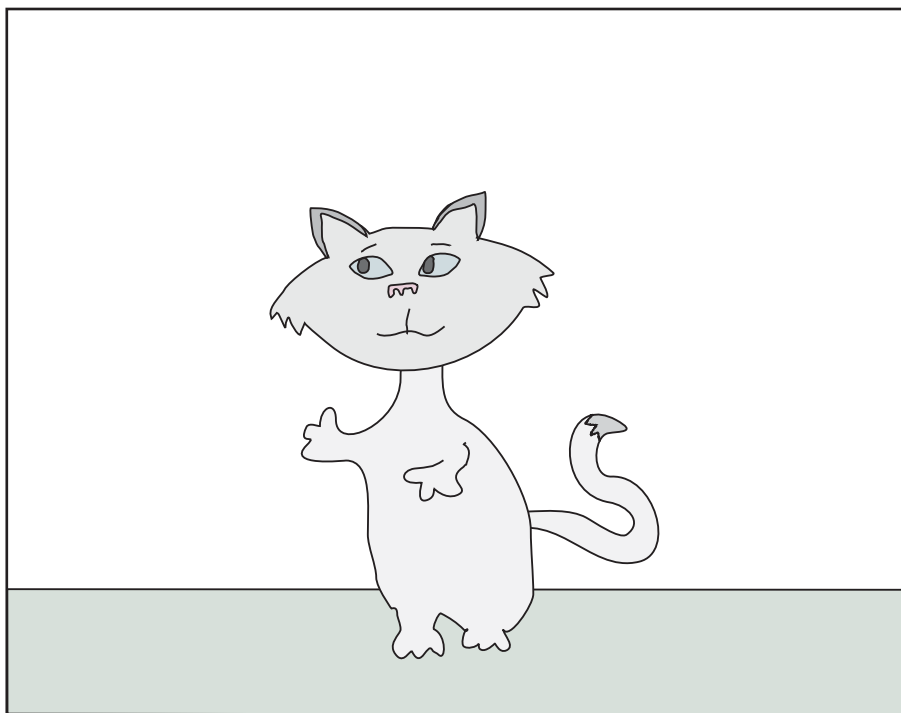
And what does the letter "r" say?

with me?”

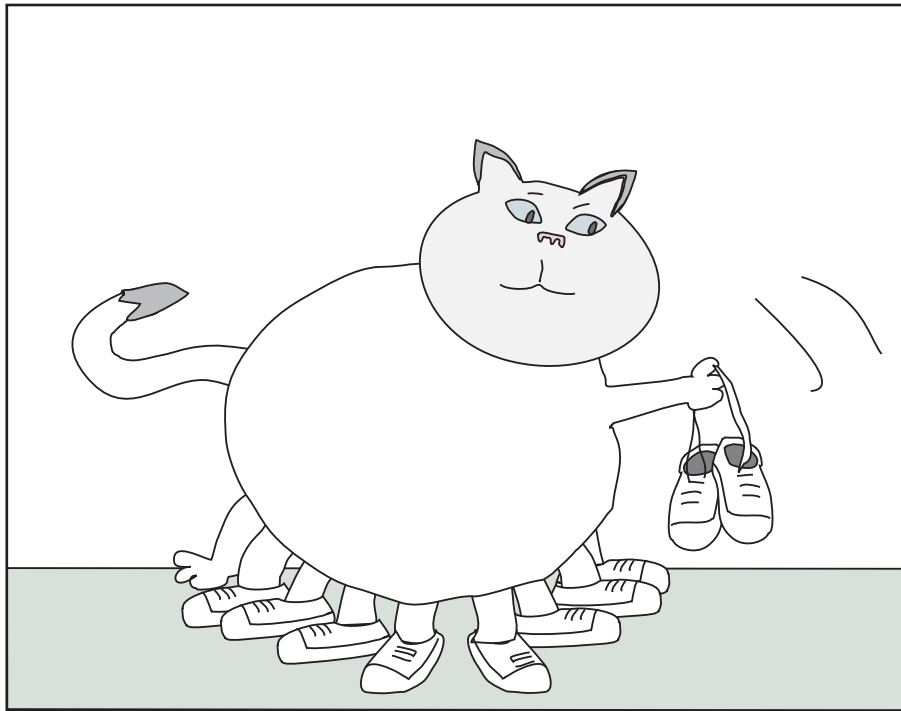


“No, thanks,” says **tim**.

not fun. My feet

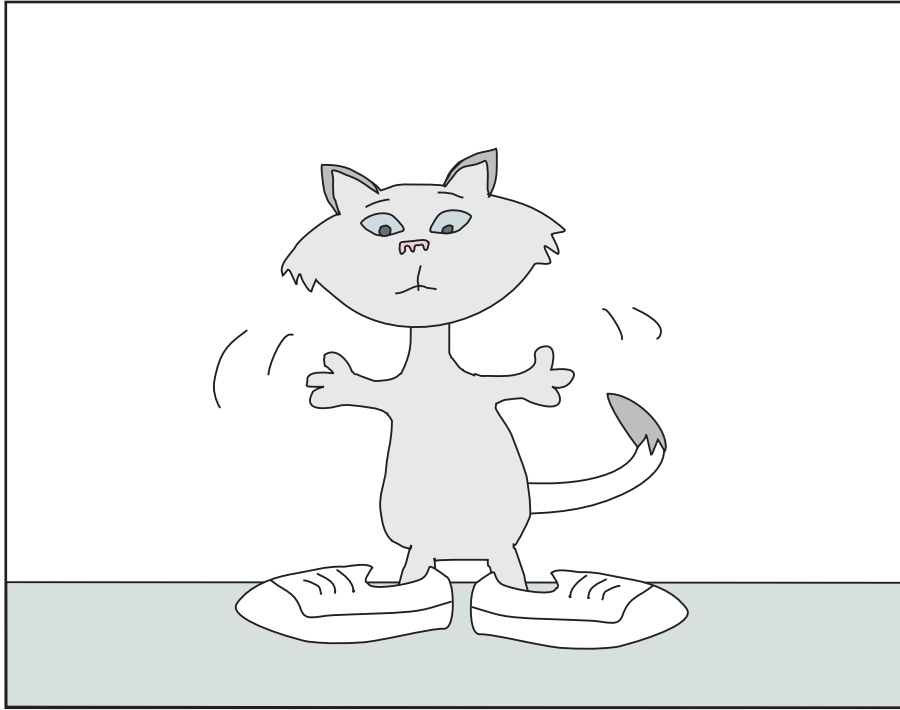
always hurt after a

eight shoes.”

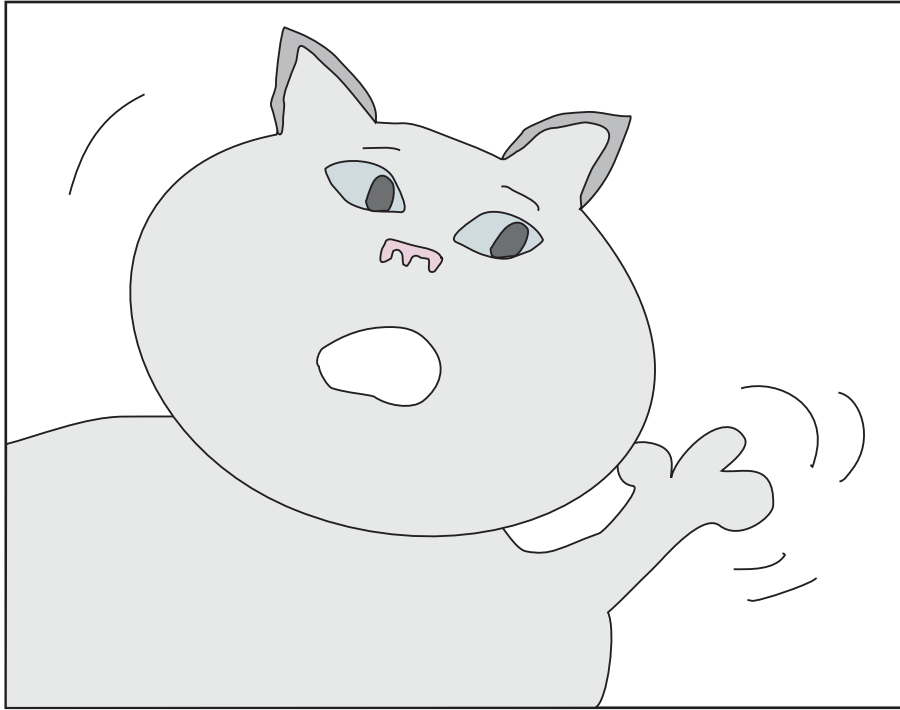


tim puts on the

are too big."

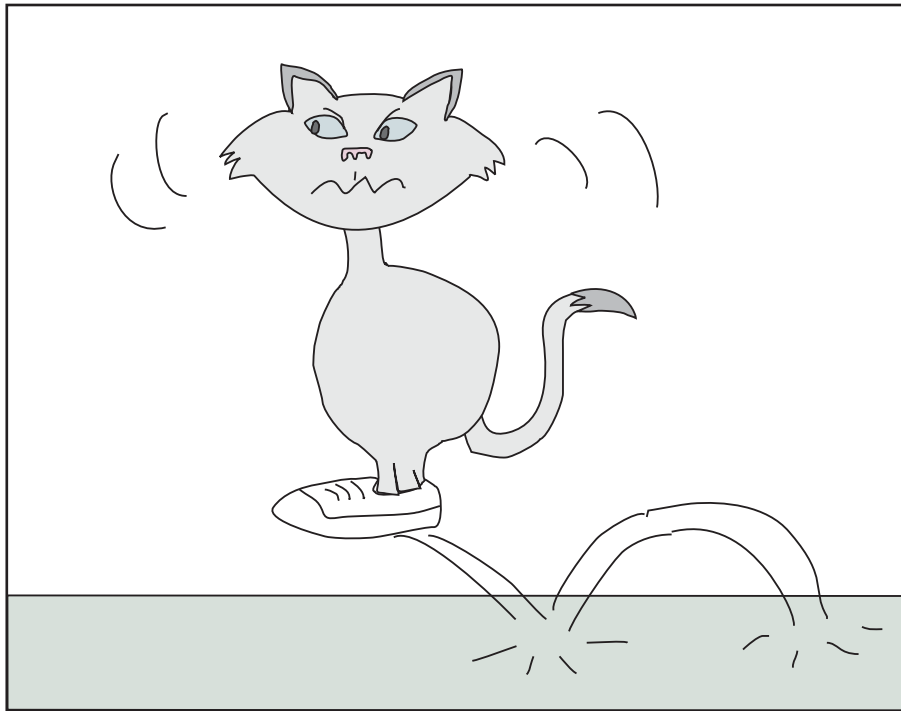


tom scratches his head.

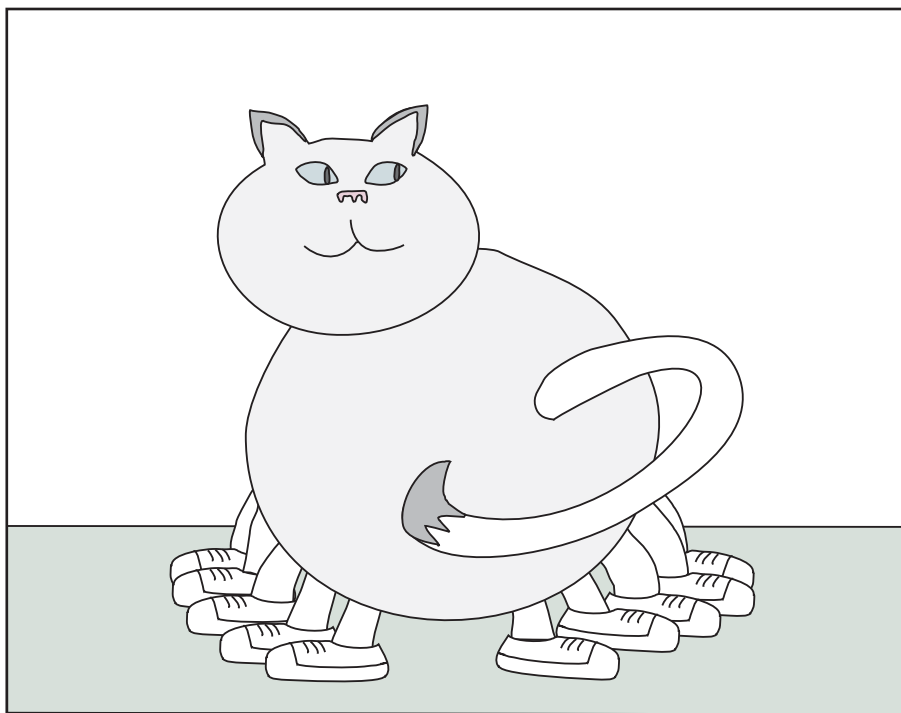
“Maybe you should put

all your feet **in** one shoe.

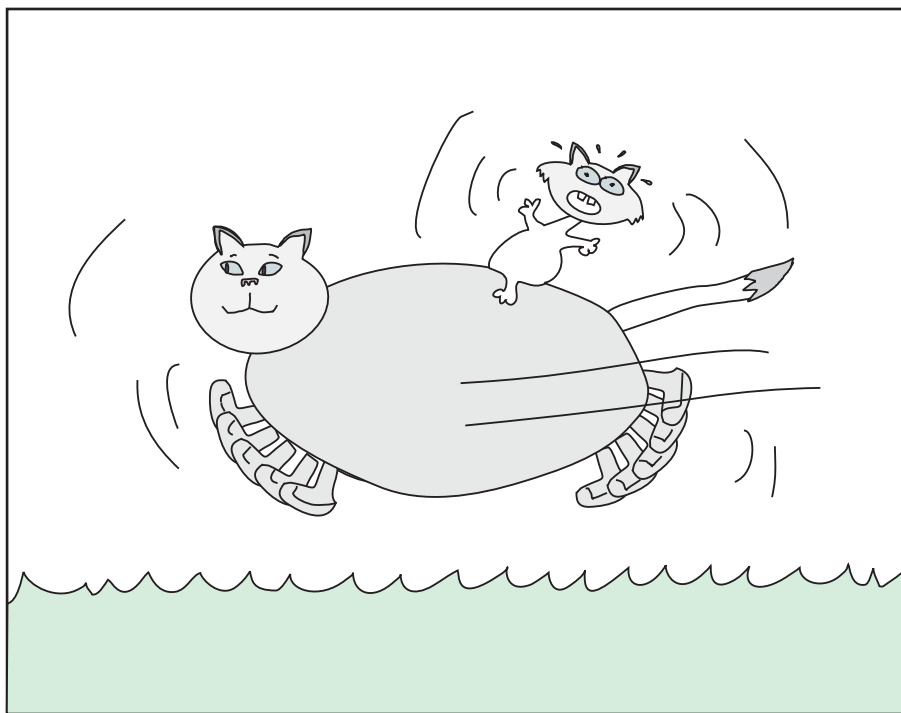
Then maybe **it** will **fit**.”

“This is **not fun**.”

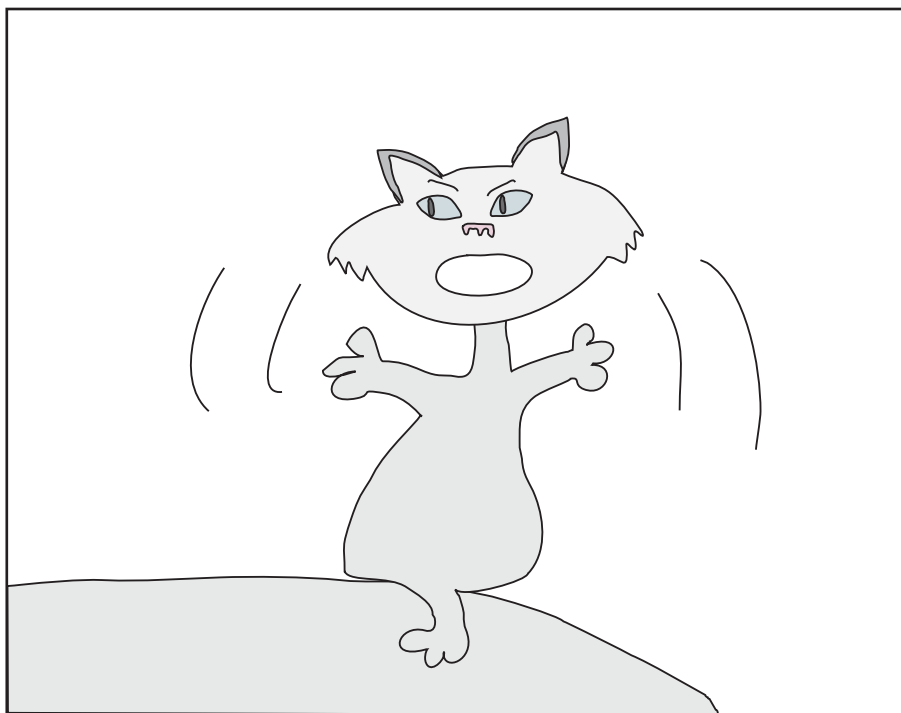
You **run** too fast!”

too quickly.”



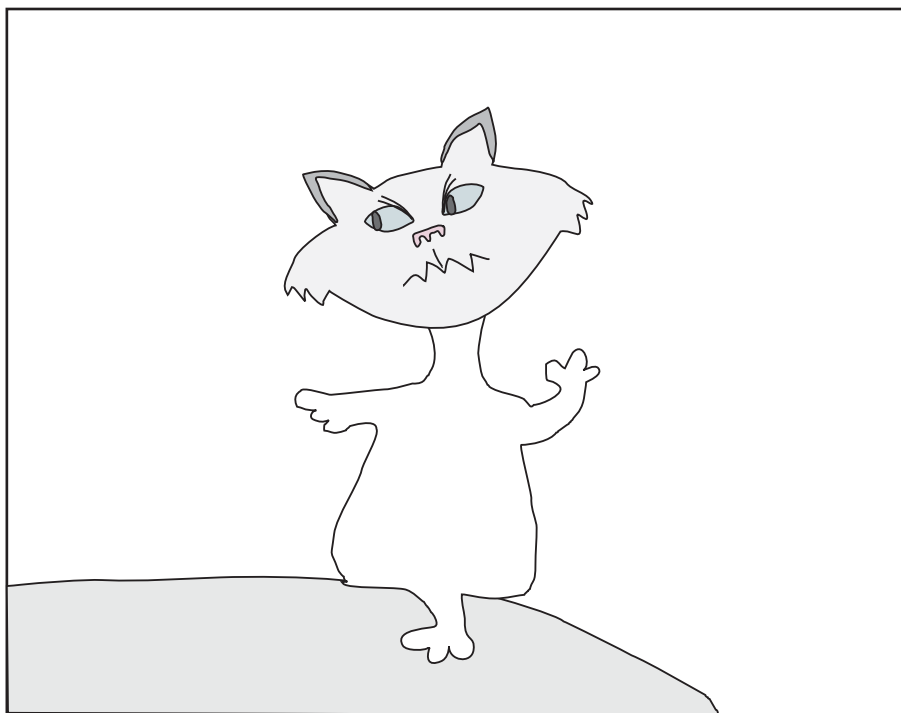
"Sickly?!" says **tom**,

feet. "**I am not**

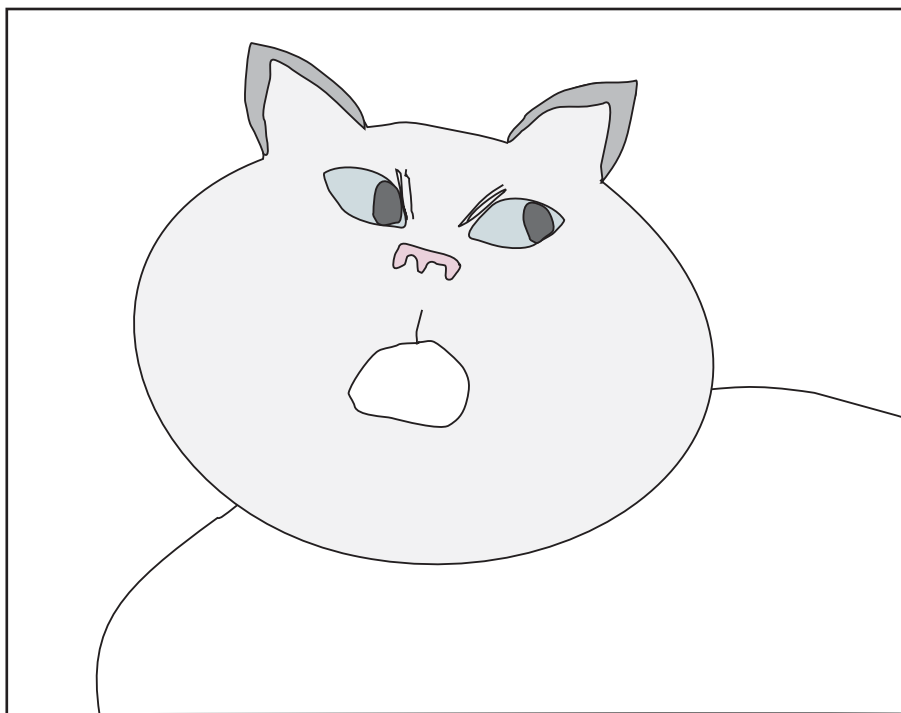
sickly. **I am** healthy -

big and healthy."



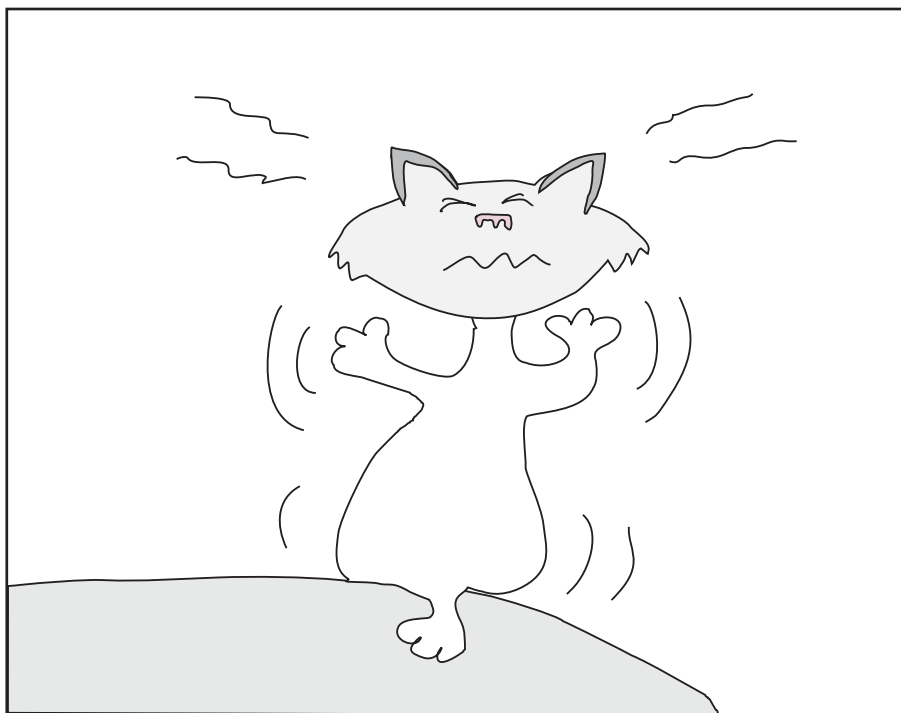
“You need your ears

hearing.”



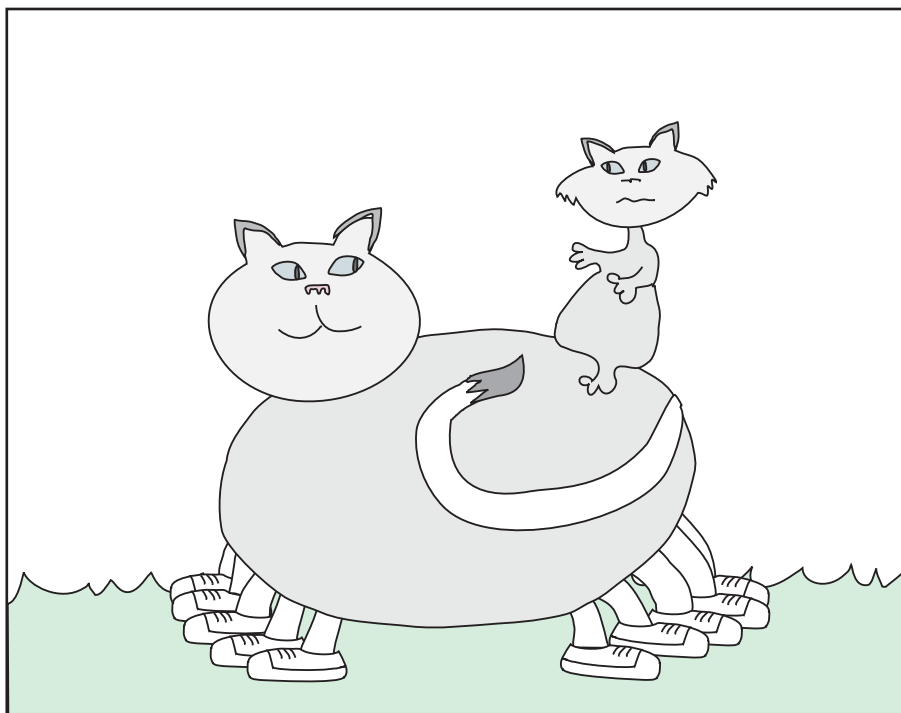
“Earrings?” says **tom**.

wearing any earrings.”



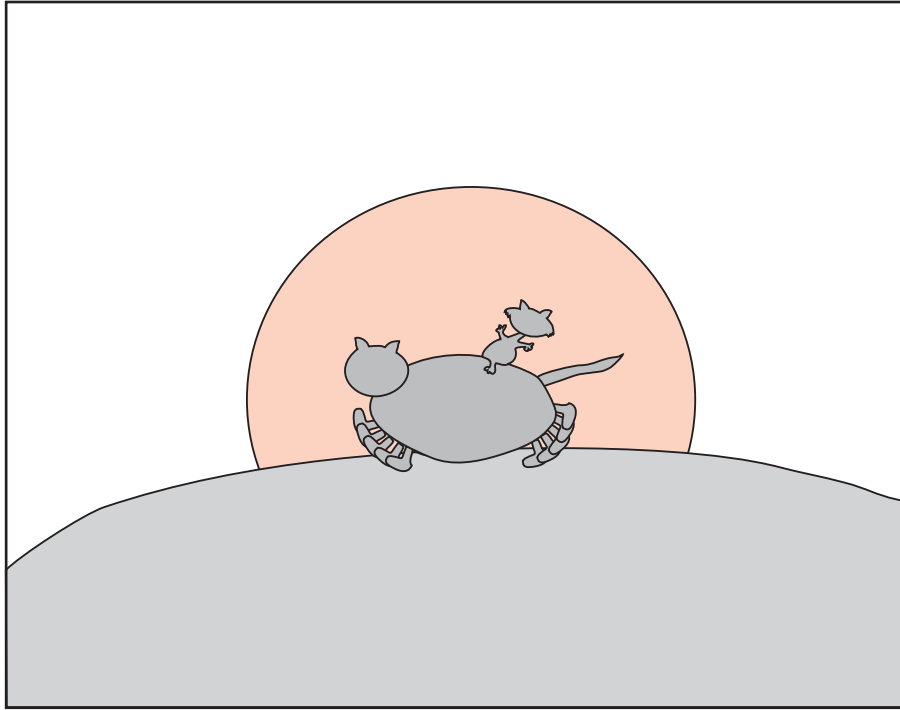
“Aaaaaaah!” says **tim**.
