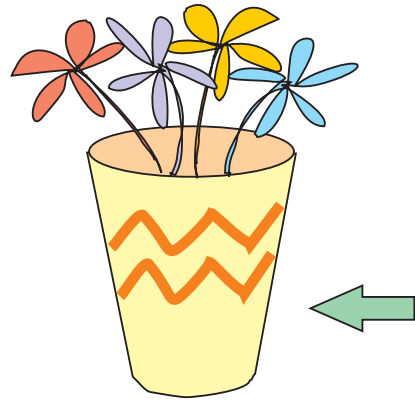

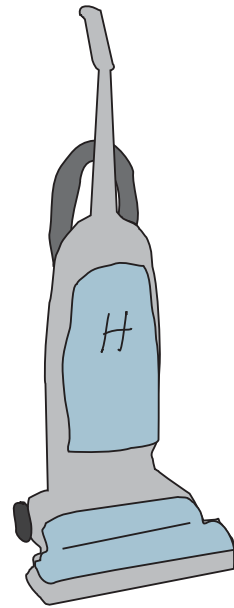

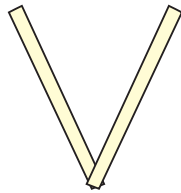
This is the letter "v." The letter "v" says "-vuh-" like in violin, vase, vacuum and vulture.



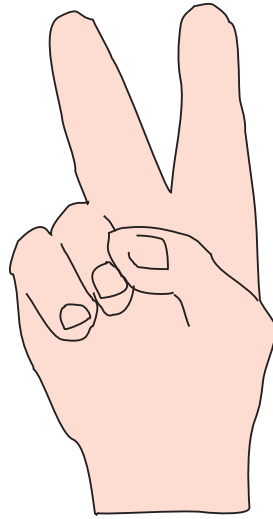
V

joined at the bottom.



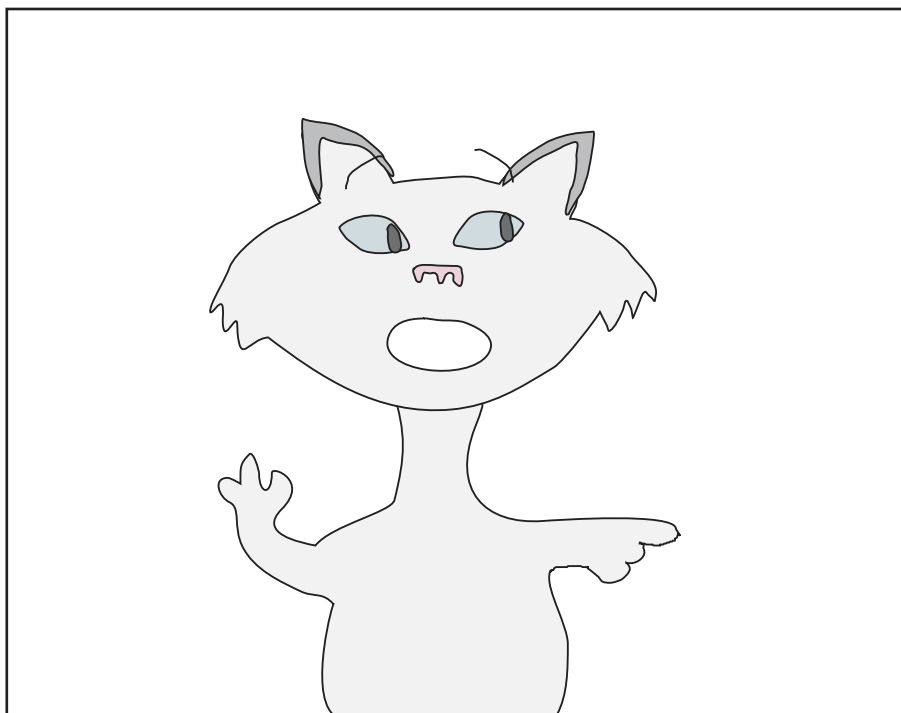
We can make the letter "v" with one hand.



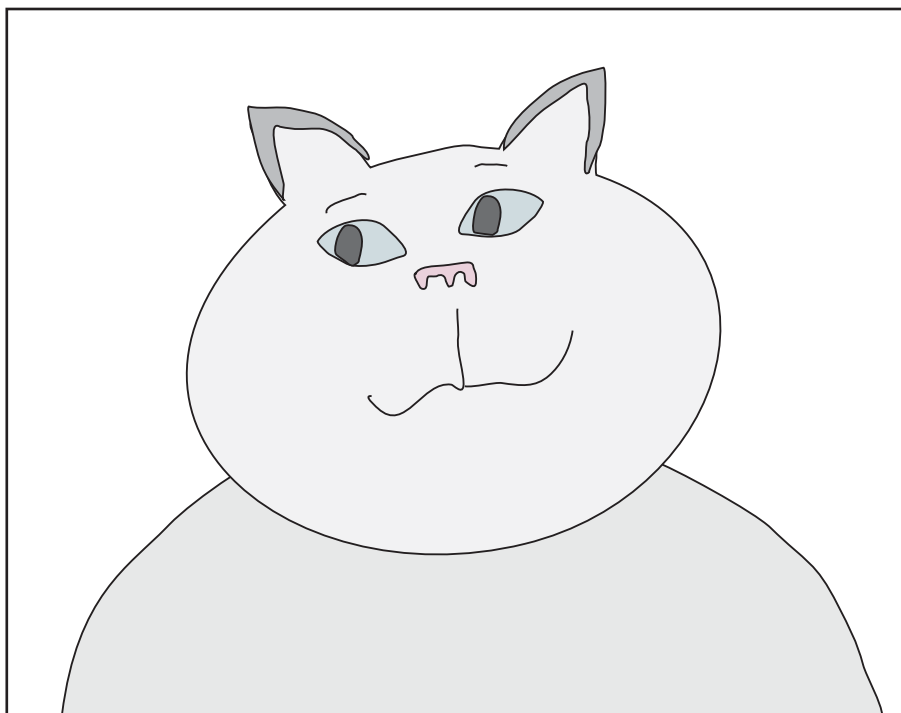
And what does the letter "v" say? (Have the child make the letter "v" sound several times.)

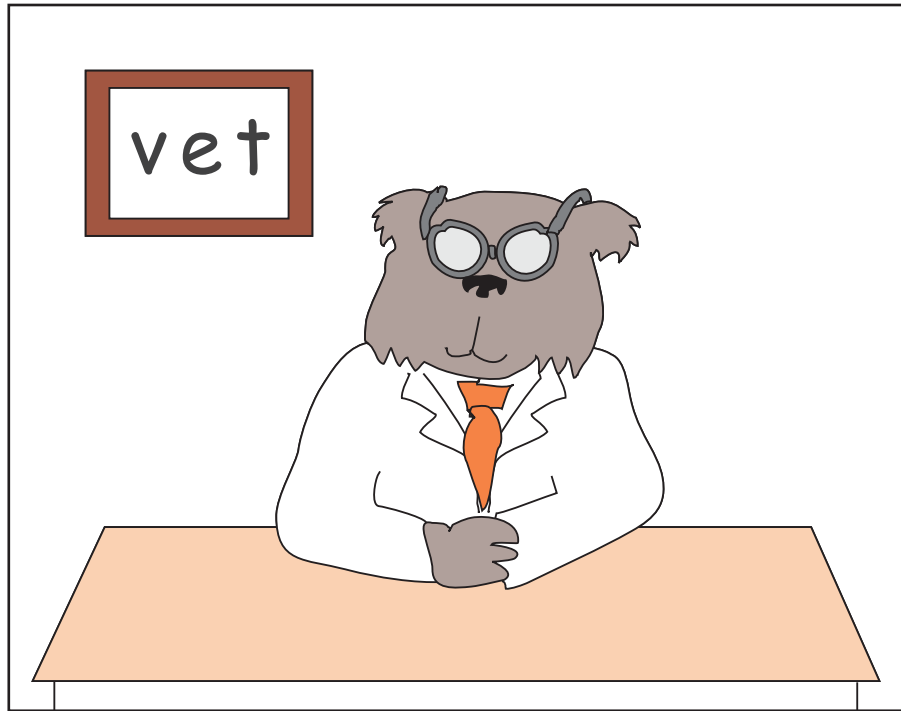
“Today, we are going

Today!”

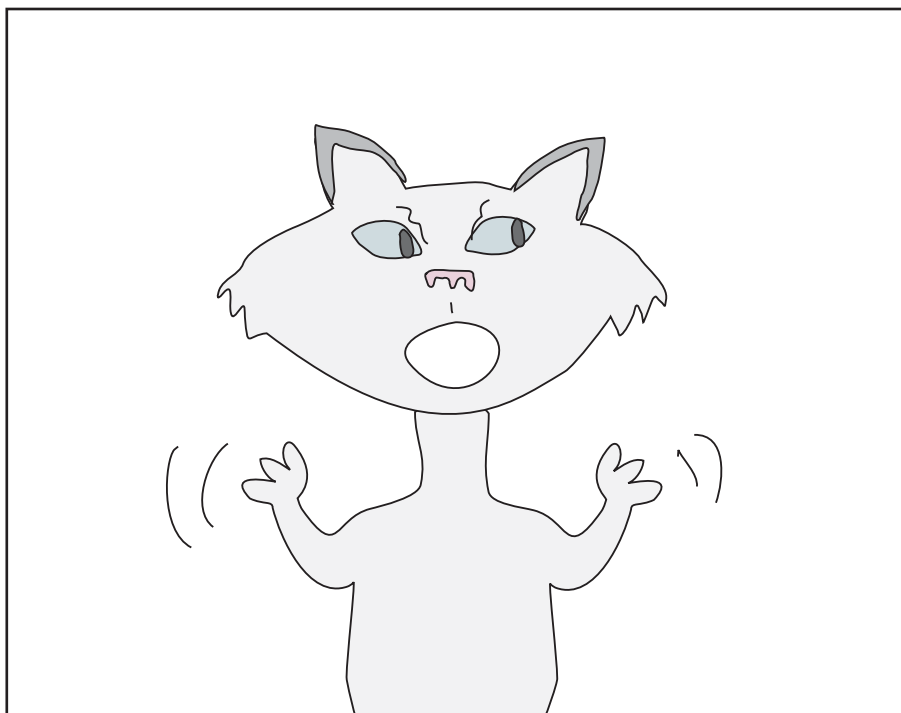


"Good morning," says the

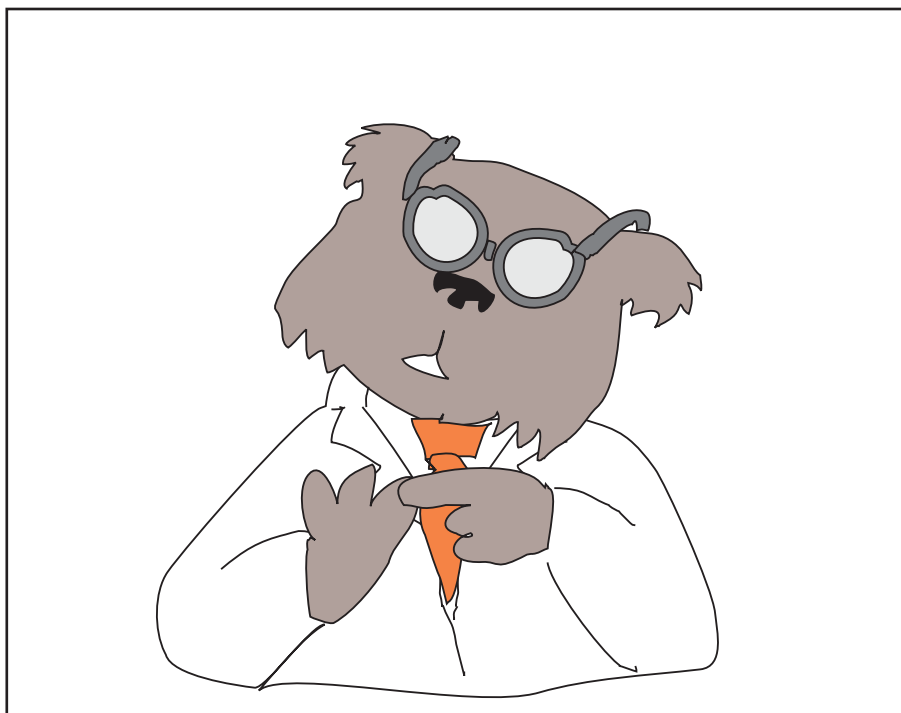
vet. "And what

not understand.”

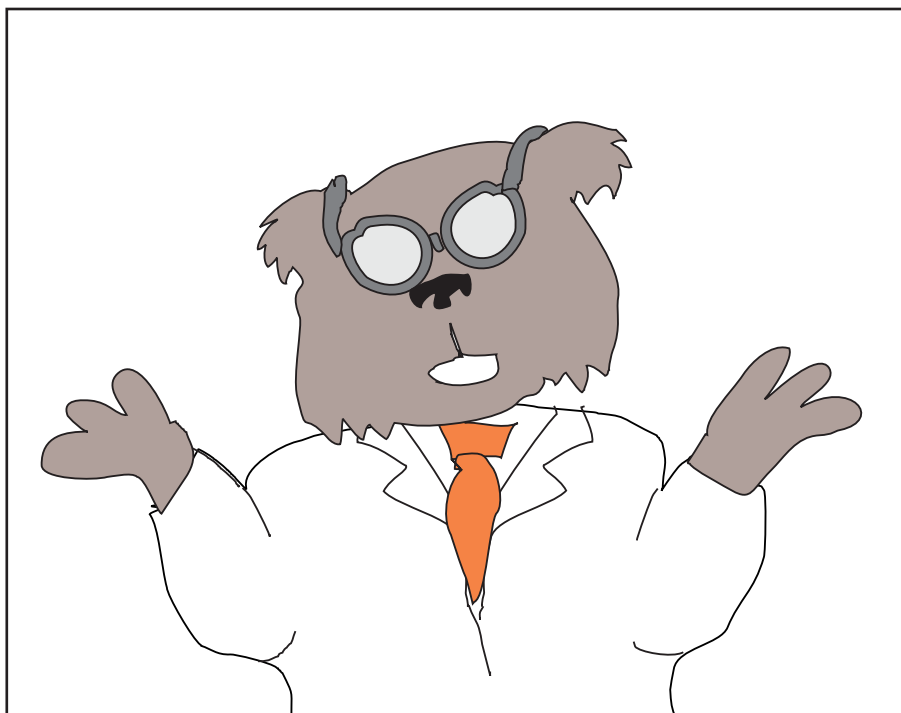


“Your hand?” asks the

hear me when **I** speak.”

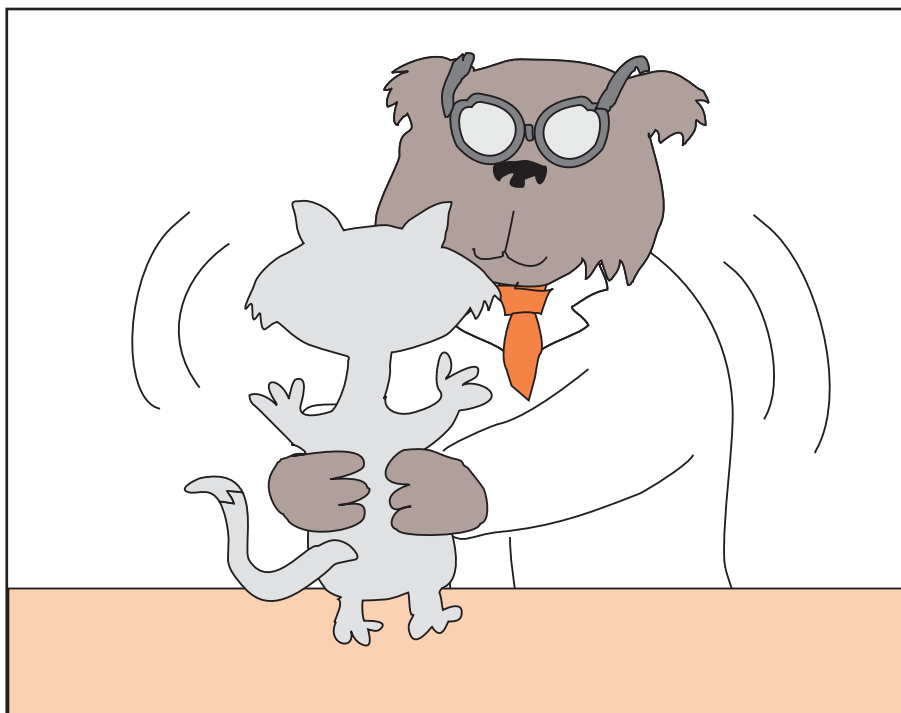


“A squeak?” asks the

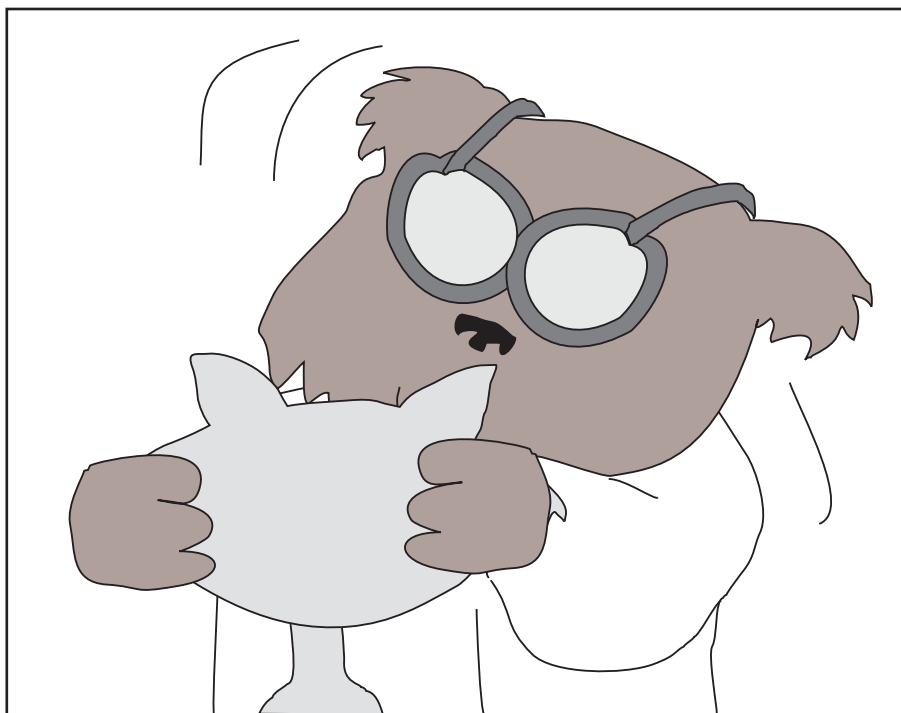
vet. “You have a

the table.

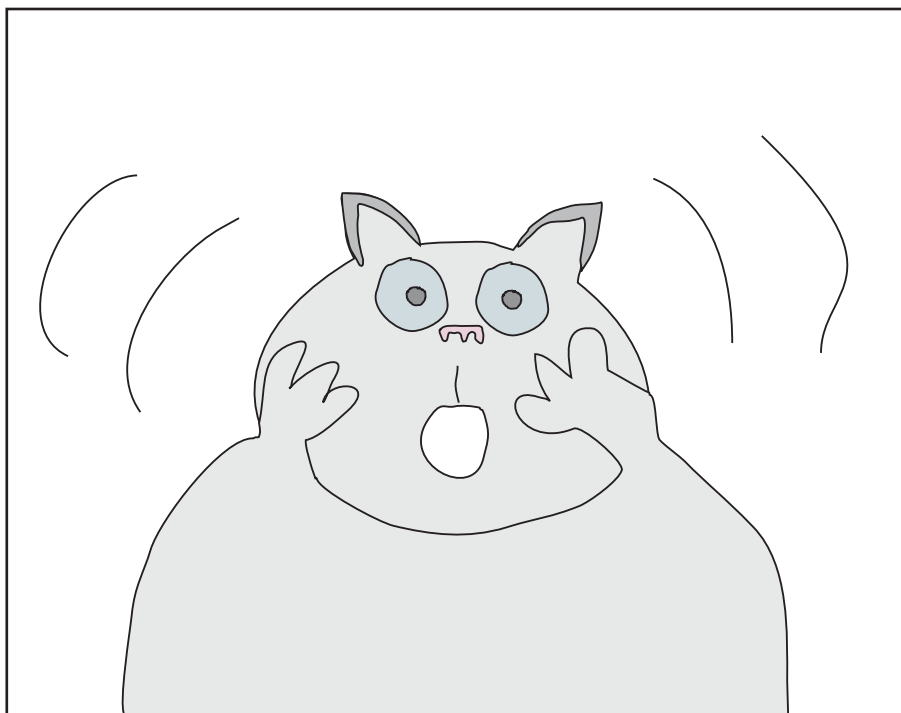


“Open wide,” says the
vet. “Say ‘aaaaah’...”

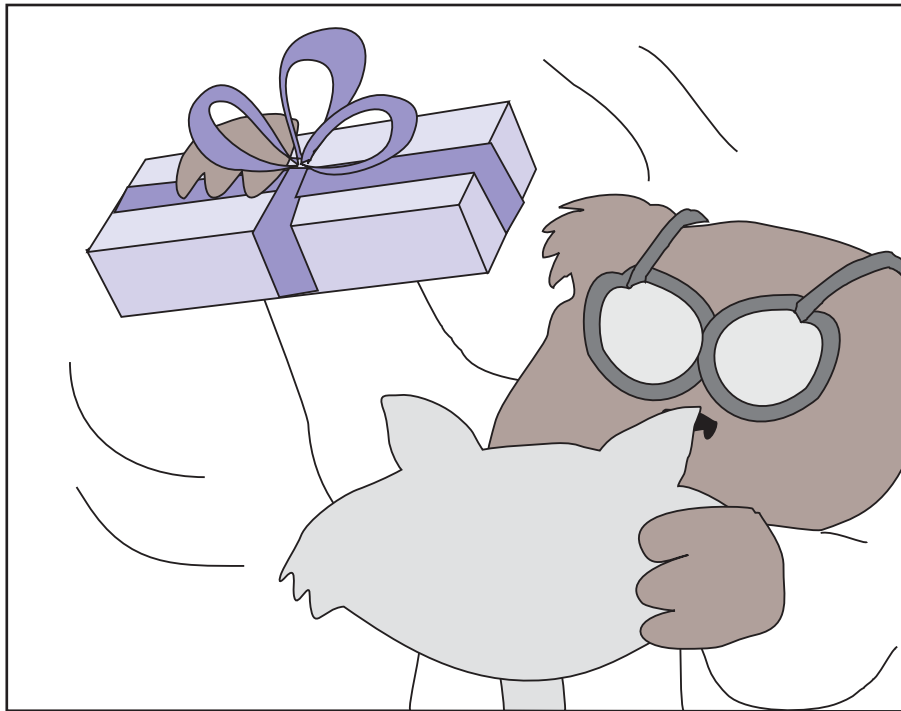
Oh, my!”

tim.



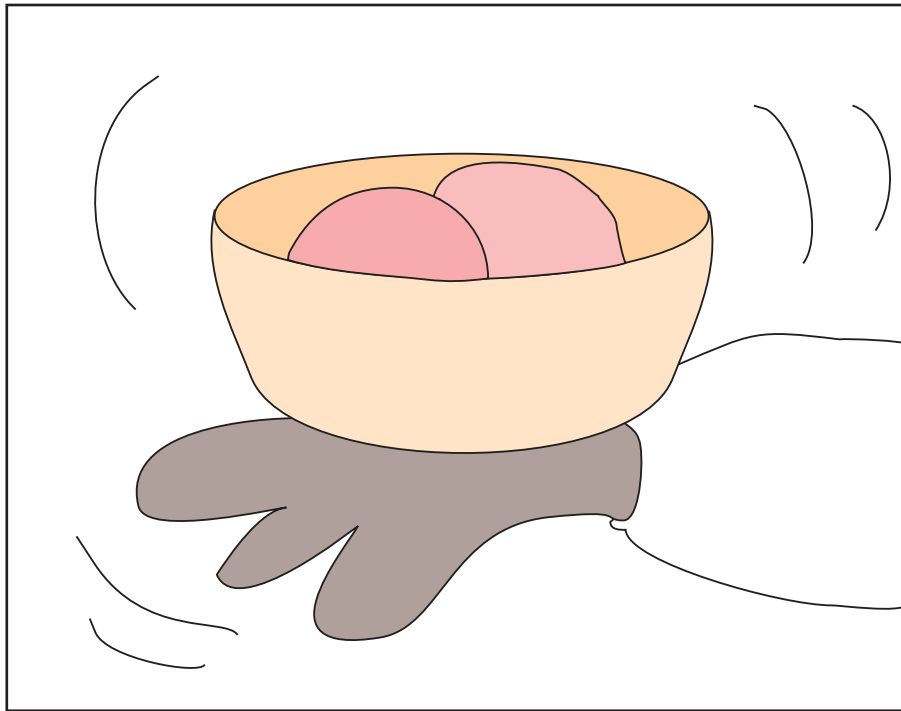
“**tim** ate the whole

who is very surprised.



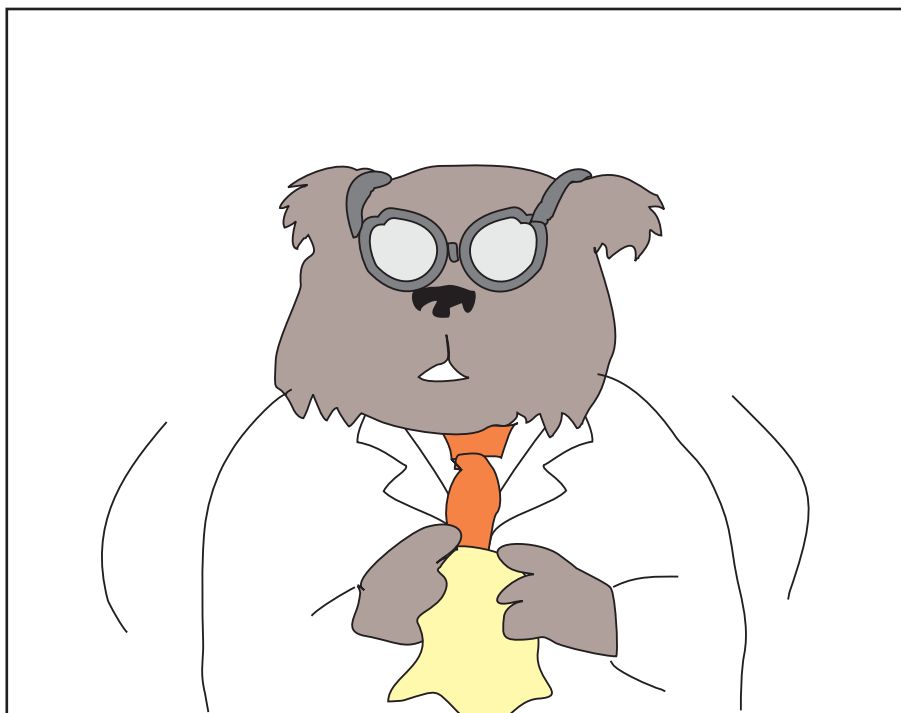
Then the **vet** pulls a

tim.



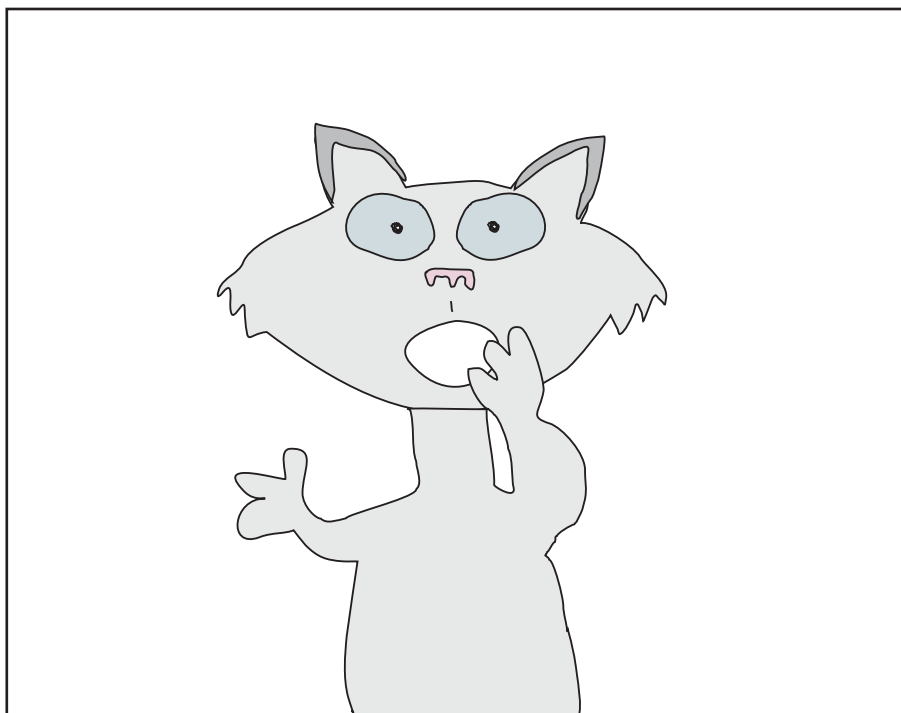
“**I** was looking for those

tim.



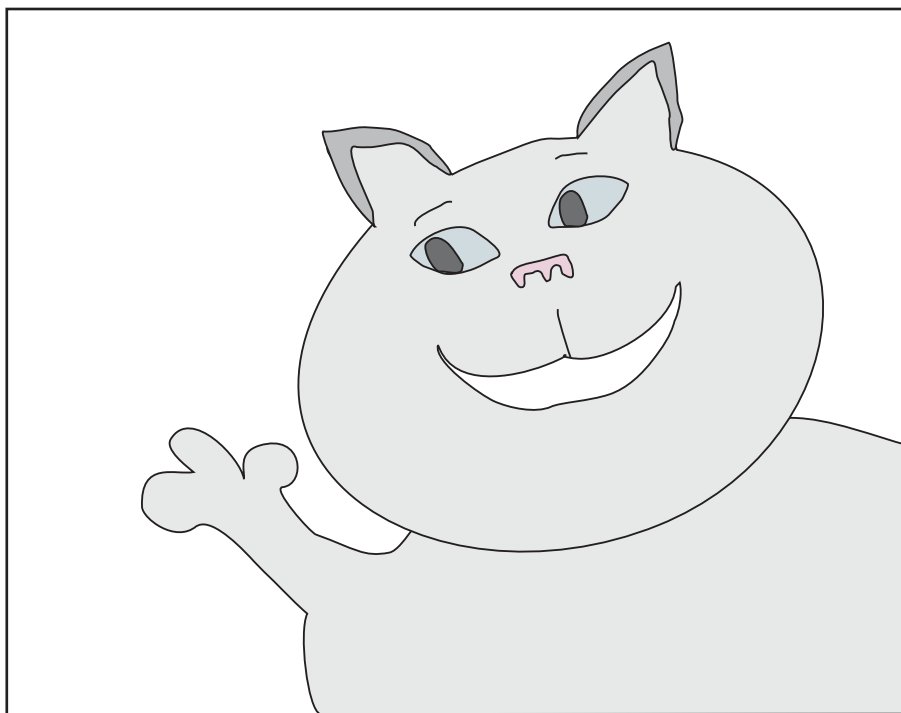
“There,” says the **vet**,

we **got** everything.”



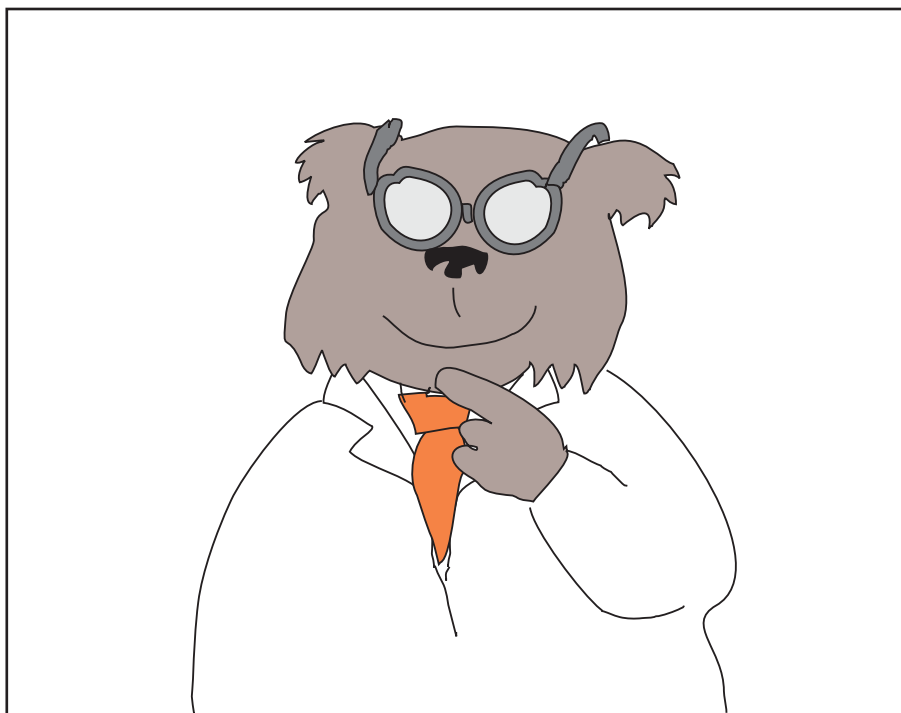
“Oh, my goodness,” says

with a **big** smile.



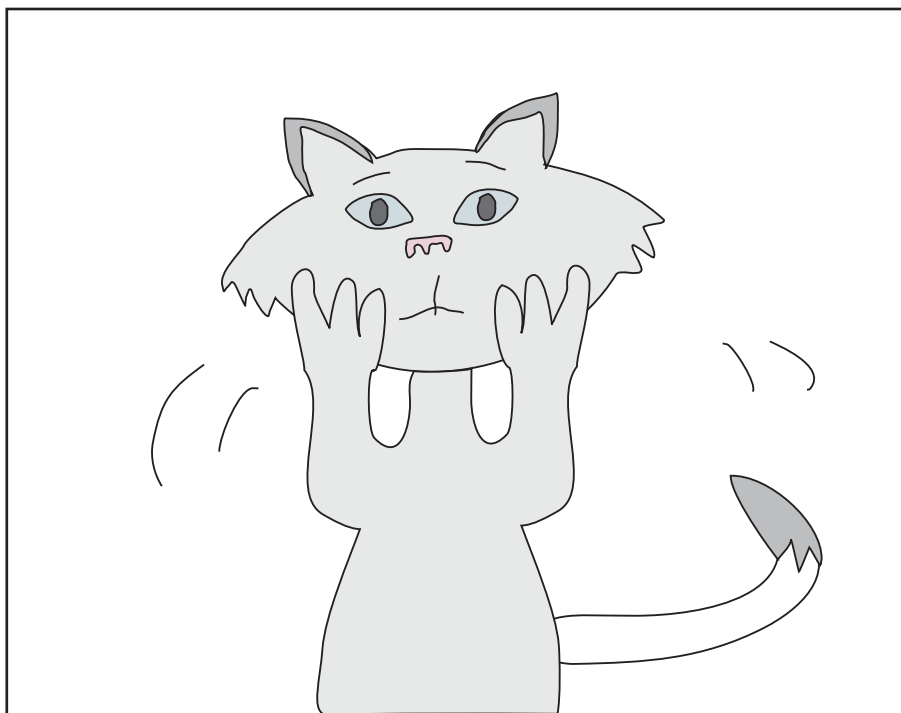
The **vet** also smiles.
