

This is the letter 'x.' The letter 'x' looks like two sticks crossing each other. Can you make an 'x' with your arms?




The letter 'x' says, '-ks-' which is a blend (mix) of two sounds: '-kuh-' like in 'cat' and '-sss-' like in 'snake.'




Here are two words that begin with the letter 'x' - xylophone and x-ray.




'X' is mostly used in the middle of words or at the end of words, like in the words, fox, box, mix and six.



The letter 'x' looks a lot like the letter 'y' but with one leg missing:



We can make the letters 'x' and 'y' with our whole body:




Another difference between the 'x' and the 'y' is how we write them. When we write the letter 'y,' the leg goes below the line, but when we write the letter 'x,' both legs stay above the line:



tom pours the cake mix in a big bowl.


Then he tries to read the instructions ON the box.



of reading glasses and looks closely at the box. "Eggs? yes, it says 'two eggs.'"




"Two legs... okay, okay,"

"What is next?"





tom jumps in the



cake **mix**!"




"I have not ruined anything," says tom.

Ding, dong! The doorbell rings.




"Surprise!" says the rabbit.

brought you guys a cake


