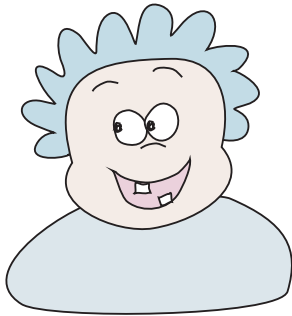

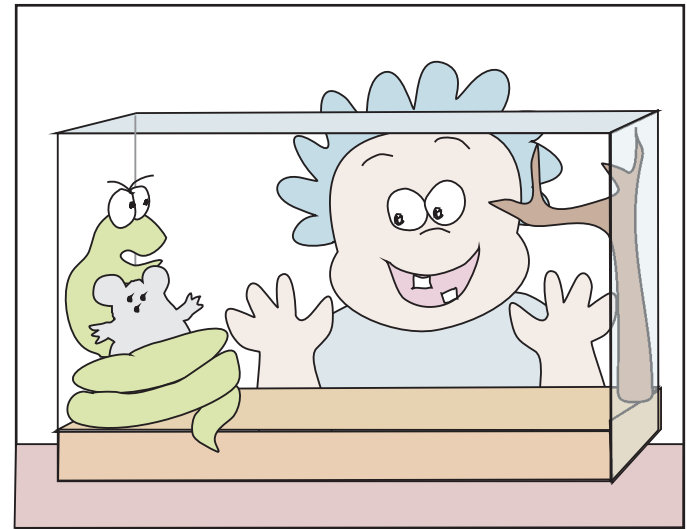

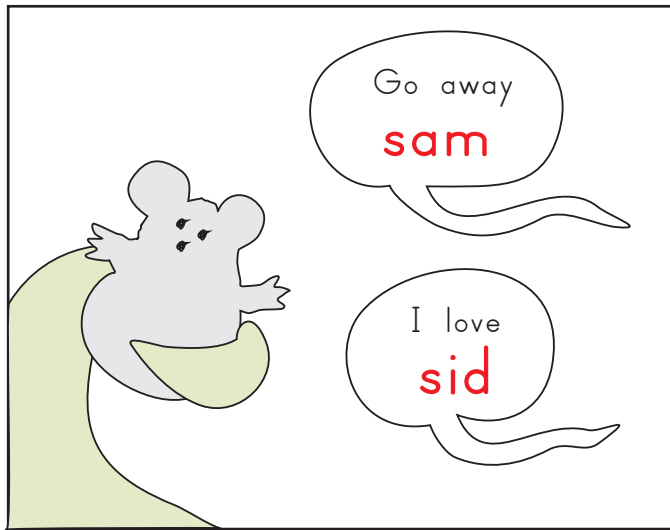

because **sid** says so.

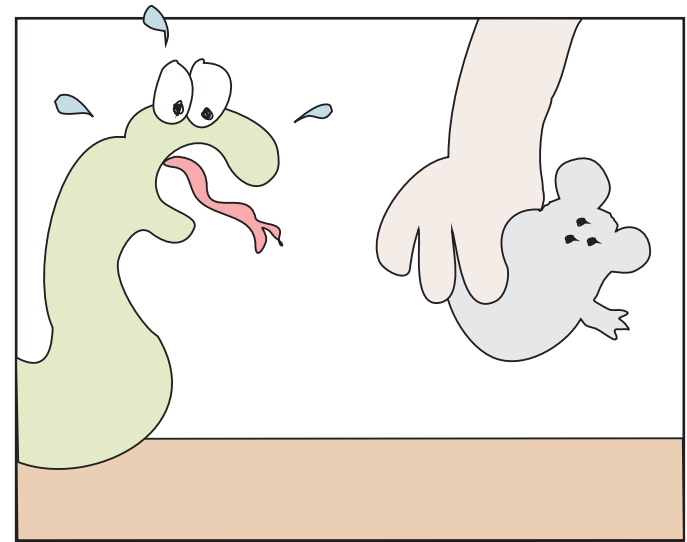


This is Baby **sam**.

But **sis** does not want to play with **sam**.

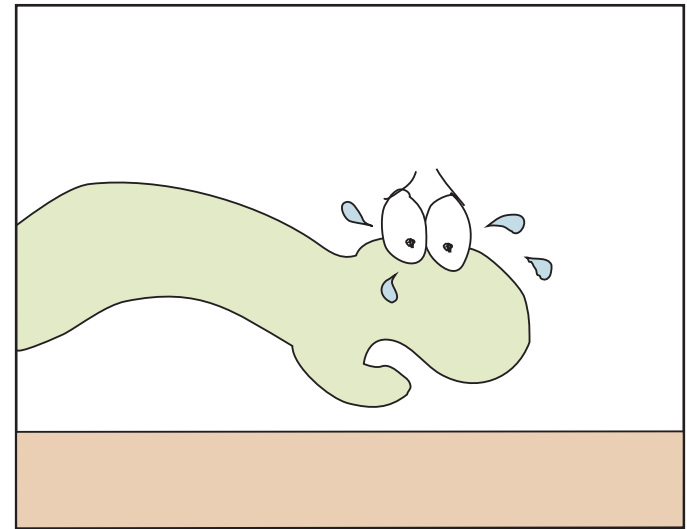
"Go away, **sam**," says **sid** for **sis**. "I want to play with **sid**."



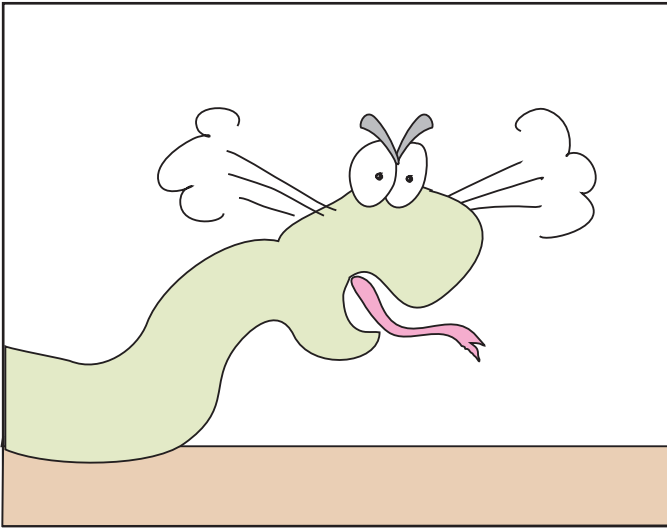
One day, **sam** reaches into the glass cage and grabs **sis**. **sis** can't scream, so **sid** screams for her. "Eeeeeeeek!"

sid. "I miss sis."



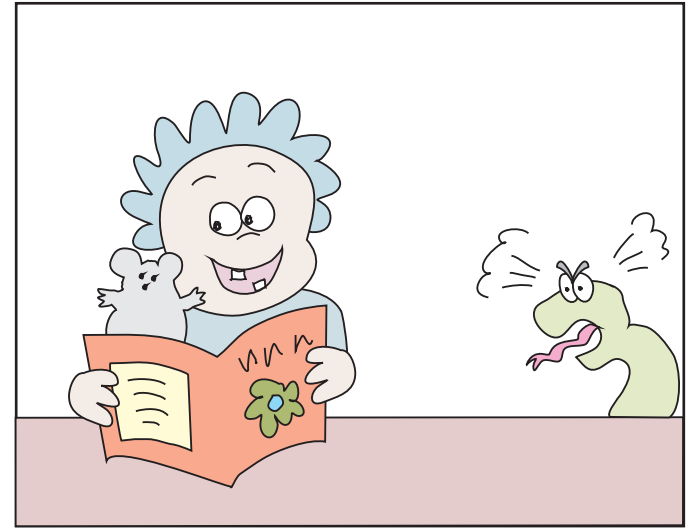
Then **sid** gets **mad**.

sam.



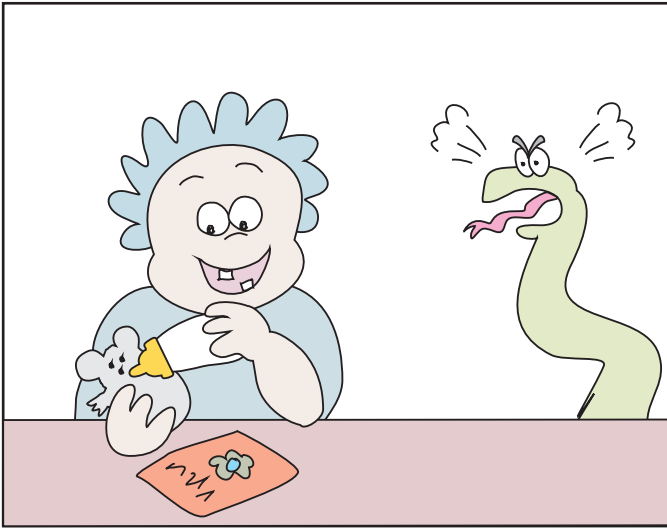
How nice! **sam** is

reading a book with **sis**.

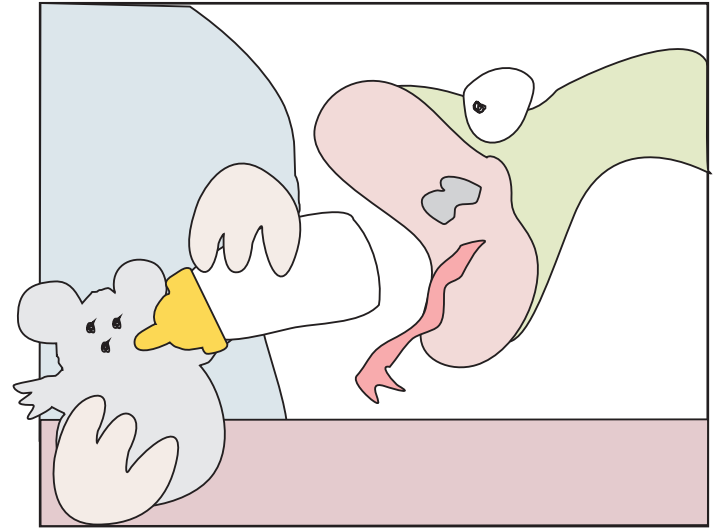
"Stop that," yells **sid**.

"**sis** can't read, and I

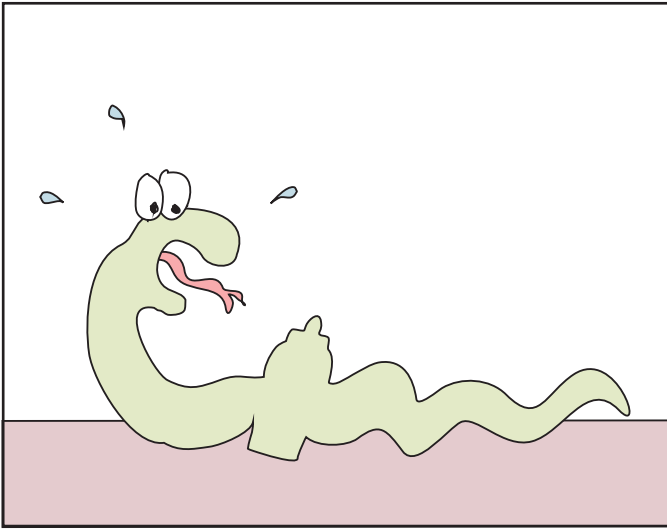
bet you can't either!"



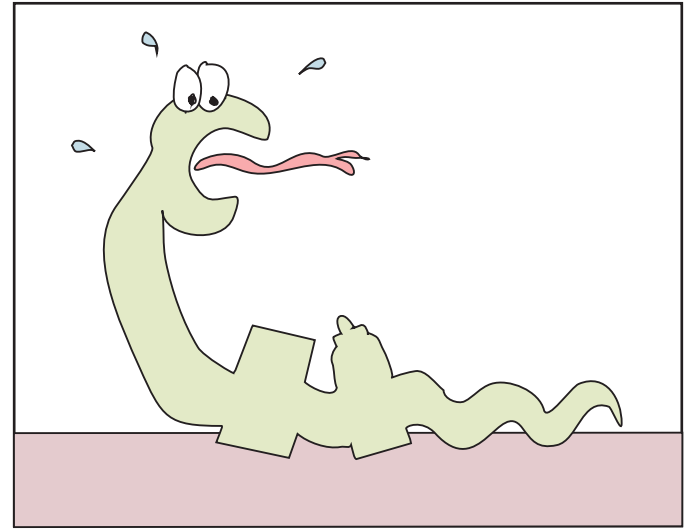
Oh, look! **sam** is

sis does not like milk!"



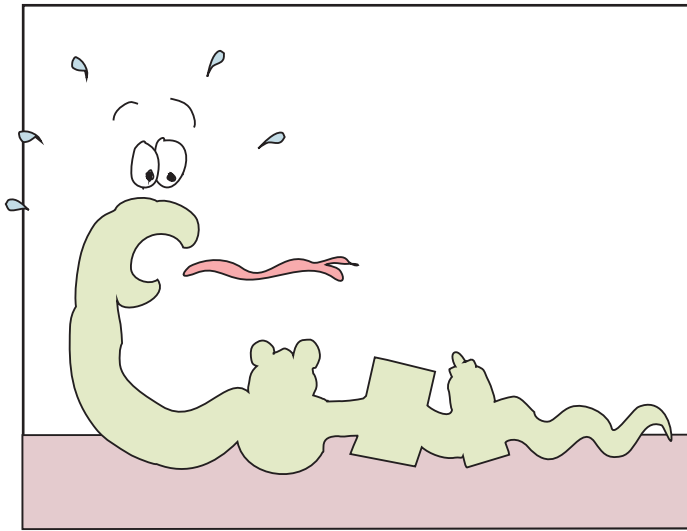
sid gets so **mad** that

mistake. Sorry, **sam**.”

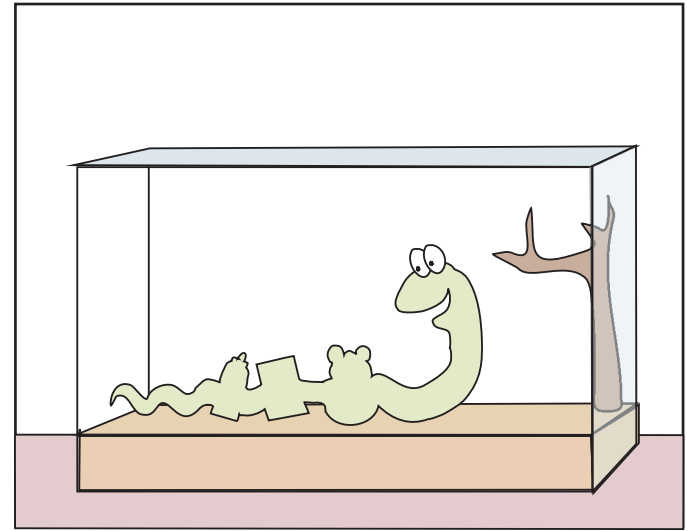


On the third grab, **sid**

“**big** mistake. Sorry,

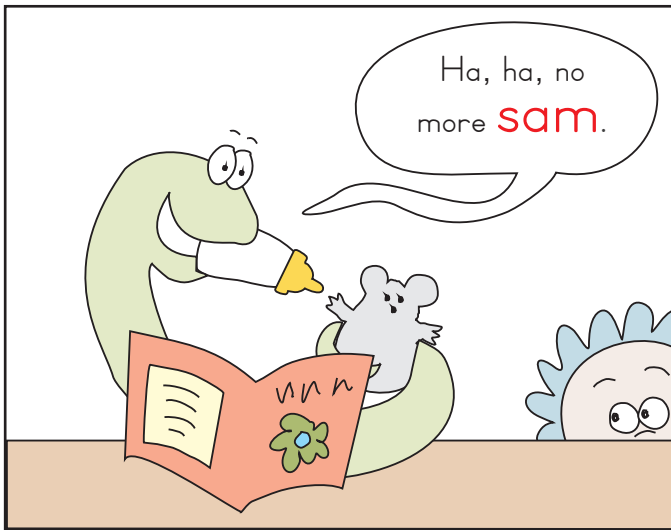
sis.”
