


sid pats sis on

sid puts sis on her shelf and then climbs in bed. "Have a nice nap," says sid as he closes his eyes.




When Sid takes a


nap, he snores. This

Bonk! SIS lands On top of Sid.




Sid wakes from his

play time."




sid puts sis back

the cage shake again.




Bonk! SiS falls On

sid again. "Oh, you silly


mouse," says Sid. "You

in my bed."




sid puts sis on her shelf and gets back in bed. Bonk! sis falls on sid again!




sid shakes his head.




Sid looks at the shelf

need a bed of your own."




Because SIS is a toy and can't speak, Sid answers for her. "Oh, yes," says

pillow.




sid tucks the blanket

nap. Soon, his snores are rocking the cage.




SIS lies in her own
